



Spooner Area Youth Hockey Association Game Day Procedures

SPECTATORS:

The Spooner Civic Center is a large facility. Each skater is allowed 4 spectators and all spectators must physically distance and be masked at all times. Children who are unable to be left home will be allowed in but must remain seated with parents at all times and be masked.

To check in players efficiently, spectators should wait until all players are checked in. Spectators will be allowed to enter 10 minutes prior to scheduled game start. Do not gather at the gate entrance and remain distanced preferably in your vehicles.

Home spectators will be expected to physically distance and be masked at all times.

Immediately following the end of the game all spectators are to exit the building from the same place they entered no more than 5 minutes after the event.

Home team parents will be responsible for wiping down all touch points for both visiting and home team areas including but not limited to, entrance points, restrooms, bleachers, players box, scores booth, refs room.

SCREENING:

There will be a screener at the **entrance** doors. Please answer the screener's questions honestly. Temperature checks may be performed at entry doors and anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to enter.

If your participant or spectators or anyone living in the same address are experiencing any of the following symptoms; fever, chills, new cough, shortness of breath, new sore throat, new muscle aches, new headache, or new loss of smell or taste; your participant is ineligible and should stay home and contact your healthcare provider. If anyone in your household is positive for Covid 19 or has a pending Covid test, keep your participant at home. If you have been exposed, have symptoms or on quarantine your participant and spectators are NOT allowed in the Civic Center. If a player, coach or spectator is turned away by the screener, please know that it is in the best interest of both teams to continue to play for weeks to come.

ENTRY:

Visiting spectators and players will enter/exit at the main entrance on Walnut Street. A sandwich board will be on the sidewalk to direct entrance. Players will be directed to the area to put on skates and the players box.

Home spectators and players will enter/exit at the rink entrance (between the stands) on Walnut Street. A sandwich board will be on the sidewalk to direct entrance. Players please proceed to the area outside of locker room #1 to put on skates and then proceed across the ice to the bench that is marked "Lumberjacks."

Early arrivals should wait in their vehicle until it is time and cleared for entering; do not gather at the door waiting to enter.

MASKS:

Masks will be worn by both spectators and players for the duration they are inside of the Spooner Civic Center.

Masks for players are defined as ear loop masks, gators or masks that attach to the cage of the helmet. If you have a medical condition that warrants not wearing a mask, please have a medical note available for the refs.

MISC:

Concessions will be open and follow food safety guidelines.

Restrooms will be open.

Touch points will be disinfected routinely.
