### 1) Call to order

- President Chuck Marino called meeting to order

- Treasurer Patrick Uhteg Jr. gave an overview of the financial statements

### 3) Report of Committees

#### • House League:

- House player registrations for Spring League were at 666
- 215 soccer balls were ordered for the U4-U6 players. Soccer balls for U4-U6 will be discontinued starting in Fall 2023

#### • Travel Soccer:

- Preliminary team division placements were sent to travel coaches for review
- Waiting for BWNYSJL to release the final team division placements and schedule
- Deadline has passed for registering dual card players with BWNYSJL
- Boys travel side – missing 4 registrations for coaching registration

#### • Tournament Committee:

- 21 teams have registered for the LDSC Travel Tournament, 12 being LDSC teams. East Aurora and Holland clubs have not registered their teams yet
- 69 teams participated in last years LDSC Travel Tournament
- Some vendors have been approved already
