- Rec Program – U6-8 has wrapped up, Rec Fest was this weekend, went well. Older kids in co-op leagues still have some time
  - i. Meeting with EVAA/VAA/Eagan on 6/14 – VAA 3-5<sup>th</sup> grade, 6-8<sup>th</sup> grade league with EVAA next season. Discuss possibility of forming teams from a whole pool of 6-8<sup>th</sup> grade kids between programs. This will allow teams to be formed by gender, and more easily fill in holes in rosters.
  - ii. Ken will work over the summer to create a wish list for equipment needs.
  - iii. Changing Terminology from “Coach” at the younger levels – goal to have more volunteer buy in from parents. Change to registration to add multi-select question with options to get more parent engagement. Ken will provide Allison with some additional language to add to the volunteer question to emphasize the need for and importance of volunteering to make your player’s experience as positive as possible. Once changes are finalized, registration is ready to open.
  - iv. Add parent meeting prior to Kickoff Camp to calendar. Ken will work with Akin for content to establish expectations for rec season, parents, players.
  - v. Explore utilizing travel coaches to help to train rec parent volunteer coaches for some practice sessions.
