The next USA Gymnastics W300/ W400 will be held in August of 2015 not in May as previously scheduled. Entries for this will be paid based on the criteria determined at the Sept 2014 meeting.

### **VI. New Business**

Summer Clinic: Ideas, dates and locations were discussed along with lecture versus hands on. The clinic will be held on July 18<sup>th</sup>.

Apparel Schedule at State and Regional Meets: It is required all committee members are a part of the apparel schedule for state meets.

Georgia Club of the Year: The Georgia Club of the year will be recognized at 9/10 regionals. We will continue to use the formula that was adopted last year.

Fall Team Finals: As team and individual participant numbers were down during the fall compulsory season, a poll will be taken during the spring compulsory meet season to decide whether team finals should be held for Levels IV and V during the fall season.  
Fall compulsory State Meets: Upon review, it was noted that some issues of protocol had been brought to the committee's attention in regards to policies and procedures prior to and at one of the state meets. This issue will be further addressed by Michelle Pomerantz with the host gymnastics facility.
