What will the recreation center do for the Kodiak community?

The current recreation center has experienced a high increase in community use. An improved facility will provide a safe, comfortable environment for members of all ages of our community to engage in healthy activities. It will have a 3-lane indoor walking track, additional bathrooms for park users, and changing/locker rooms. It will create a place for our youth to practice sports and host out-of-town teams for baseball, football, track soccer, tennis, and hockey. It will support the expansion of the Kodiak Hockey League program and the development of a co-ed high school hockey team.

How will my contributions be utilized?

Your contribution will be an important part of the community campaign, and will help pay for construction fixtures and equipment for our new facility.

How will my contribution be held during construction?

Your contribution will be held in the Friends of Baranof Park / Kodiak Hockey League (KHL), an interest bearing account dedicated to Baranof Park improvements. It is subject to an official Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Kodiak and is separate from all KHL funds. To ensure your intent as a donor is met, the Friends of Baranof Park/ KHL will remand funds to the city only as project milestones are reached. The KHL, a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, is the steward of campaign funds. Your contribution may be tax deductible.

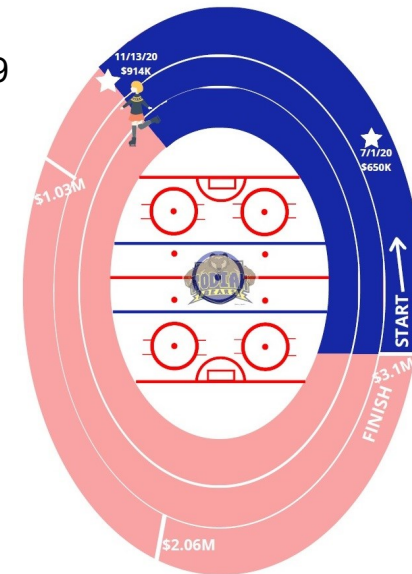
