



Team Award

The Ontario Volleyball Hall of Fame honours athletes, teams, coaches, officials, and builders who have had a significant impact on volleyball in Ontario. Inductees exemplify the best in the history of the sport in our province.

Eligibility & Selection Criteria:

Team Category

- Team must have been based in the Province of Ontario during the time of the accomplishment(s).
- Team must have competed in a league or system that is recognized by Ontario Volleyball.
- Any team (consisting of able bodied or athletes with disabilities) that has attained a high level of excellence and brought recognition or honour to volleyball at a national or international level in relation to open level competition. Team members are recognized as part of a team and not as an individual Honoured Member.
- Accomplishments that may be considered include, but are not limited to:
 - Exceptional single seasons (e.g. undefeated championship teams).
 - Exceptional unbeaten streaks.
 - Any other exceptional accomplishments (e.g. participation in Olympic Games, FIVB World Championships, etc.).
- The Ontario athletes of a Canadian Team, which has reached special excellence on a national or international level, may be nominated and inducted as a group in the “Team” category.
- Teams are selected for achievements in one year, not an era.
- Exceptions:
 - A team is not eligible for nomination until three (3) years following the year which a team is nominated for except by winning an Olympic or a World championship gold medal whereby the nomination is eligible for immediate consideration. For example, a team from 2013 would be eligible to be nominated for the 2016 induction class.
