

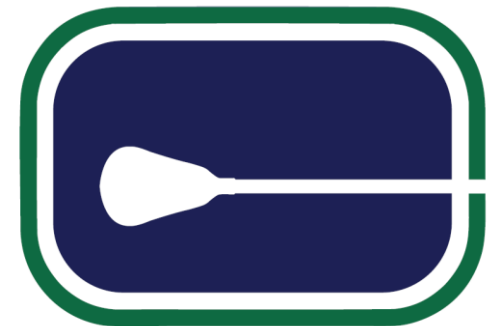

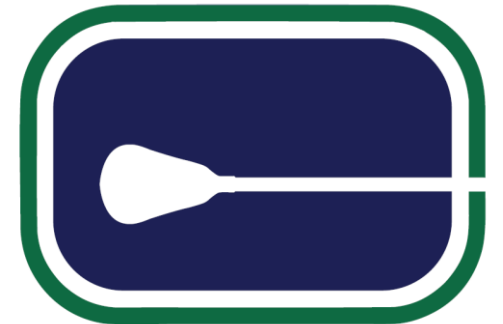
# 2019 Season Overview 8U & 10U

- Indoor Dakota Box League
  - Practices & Games at Eagan Civic Arena
  - Parent Coaches
  - End of Season Jamboree
  - Early March – April 19th
- Spring/Summer Field Season (GNLL) runs April 20<sup>th</sup> – June 13th
- 8U 6 game schedule
- 10U 8 game schedule + state tourney (June 15/16)
- Tournament – Eagan Wildcat Faceoff June 1<sup>st</sup> and 2nd



# 2019 Season Overview 12 & 14U

- Indoor GNLL Boy Youth Pre-Season Box League
  - Warm ups start March 7th
  - 6 regular season games (March 16th – April 20th) – off week of SB
  - Games on Saturdays and Sundays
  - League provides: Certified UMLOA officials, EMT's, Site Managers, Scorekeepers, & Mobile Standings
  - Location: Eagan Civic/Apple Valley Hayes
  - Equal teams will be created at both levels for box
- Evaluations for Spring Field
  - April 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> – Savage Dome
  - A & B Teams will be formed
- Outdoor practices begin after Box season
  - Practices will be held at Northview Elementary
- Teams will play a 10 game GNLL schedule
- Tournament – one per team
- State Tourney June 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>
- 12U – 22, 14U - 44

## **Team Manager**

- Manages all aspects of team coordination including liaising with the Summer Field Director, Age Level Coordinators, Equipment Coordinator, Merchandising Coordinator, Coaches, Players & Parents to assure the season runs smoothly for all involved.

## **CHILL Manager**

- According to US Lacrosse, each youth team is required to have a Sideline Manager. A CHILL Manager is YLM's variation of that requirement. A CHILL Manager is a team parent who is responsible for monitoring and enforcing US Lacrosse's and YLM's sportsmanship directives and stands for "Cool Heads Instill Life Lessons". On game days CHILL managers from both teams meet at the scorer's table, remain visible to officials during the game, and politely ask parents/fans to act respectfully towards officials, other teams' coaches and players. They will report unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches or fans to [www.youthlaxmn.org](http://www.youthlaxmn.org).
