



COVID-19 Limited Re-Opening Policy and Procedures – Updated as of March 19, 2021

Entry procedures

- Arrival time must not be any more than 15 minutes before the scheduled ice time.
- Upon arrival at the rink, skaters and coaches are to use the front entrance of the building, entering using the right hand doors and following the arrows to the right hand staircase leading down to dressing room area.
- The purchaser of the ice/main contact will make sure all participants are screened for COVID-19 based on the information on the Minto Skating Centre website (www.mintohockey.com) and they have collected contact information to support contact tracing.
- Masks must be worn at all times, inside the facility, with the exception of the on-ice portion of the visit
- NO SPECTATORS
- ONE parent/guardian, of children under the age of 12, is permitted to enter the skate tying area of the facility to tie their children's skates if they are incapable of doing so.
- ONE parent/guardian per player will be permitted to supervise in the designated viewing areas per hourly session (must be the same individual as above) – **SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE PRACTICED WHILE OBSERVING THE SKATE** failure to do so will be grounds for removal from the facility.
- Dressing rooms will be off-limits and **participants will need to arrive fully dressed**

Ice Surface Entry and Exit

- **Showers will continue to be off-limits to all MSC users**
- **Masks must be worn until entering the ice surface and need to be replaced after leaving the ice surface**
- **Dressing rooms are closed and off-limits**
- **Chairs will be placed in the hallway for tying skates**
- **All personal items must be taken onto the ice**
- **Benches will be placed outside of the ice surface to take skates off. Participants must leave immediately. No full changes will be permitted**

Icetime Usage – Social Distancing Measures

- Scrimmaging and game-play is not permitted. All activities must maintain a physical distance of two metres at all times
- A maximum of **ten (10)** on-ice participants, including coaches are to use the NA or DJ ice surface per rented hour. Failure to comply by this rule or distancing requirements will result in immediate removal from the facility and a non-refundable cancellation of that icetime.
- A maximum of **ten (10)** on-ice participants, including coaches are to use the studio ice surface per rented hour. Failure to comply by this rule or distancing requirements will result in immediate removal from the facility and a non-refundable cancellation of that icetime.
- No showering is permitted at the Minto Skating Centre

Exiting the Facility

- All participants must exit the facility within 10 minutes of the completion of their ice time
- Use the main staircase in the middle of the dressing room hallway and follow the arrow to exit the facility
