Pre-academy Expectations 2020/2021

The USA Pre-Academy program provides a bridge between recreational and competitive soccer. The program is designed for players who would like to enhance their skills, learn new techniques, and improve current playing abilities within a professional training, age appropriate environment. The Pre-Academy program is operated by a combination of USA approved professional coaches and volunteer parents.

Utah Alliance Competition Club expects all Pre-academy players to meet certain requirements. This includes participation for the entire seasonal year which begins following registration and continues through the Fall and Spring soccer seasons.

After registration, players will be placed within training groups based on their individual skills, commitment level, and attitude. Approved breaks and appropriate off seasons for rest and holidays are included in the USA schedule. We expect players to participate in Club sponsored camps and field player training sessions, as appropriate to their playing level.

Players are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship to ALL coaches, players, referees, and spectators. Players are expected to arrive at all soccer activities and events on time and be ready to play. Program Goals U7 and U8

- Improve individual player technical ability, such as; dribbling, passing and receiving, attacking and defending 1v1, ball striking and finishing.
- Provide players the opportunity to learn and play multiple positions.
- Create a fun, healthy, learning environment.
- Provide the platform for players to fall in LOVE with the game.
- Introduce players to the USA soccer family.

Parent Role U7 and U8

- Parents have a big role in a player's progress. With your help we can make soccer a wonderful experience.
- Let your player learn and grow on their own. Focus on the playing and development process, not the result.
- Cheer for all players when they do well and refrain from making negative comments about any player.
- No coaching from the sidelines. It's the player's game, let them play it.
- Commit to ZERO tolerance for referee criticism and be a better example.

Services from USA Competition Club and Fee Schedule

Pre-Academy: U7 and U8

All Players: Annual Club Fee: U7 and U8 \$395

- **One weekly one hour indoor training session, November thru March.**
- USA professional staff coaches will be assigned to all training groups.
- During the Fall and Spring seasons, three weekly training sessions, games, or street soccer events.
- During the Summer, two weekly training sessions, games, or street soccer events.
- Periodic training sessions and specialty training with the DOC, TD or staff coaches.
- Training/match observation, including technical and tactical assessment by DOC, TD or staff coaches.
- Training sessions will be 60-75 minutes long.

Uniform and Ball:

All new players to the USA Club MUST purchase a uniform to participate. New uniforms were required to be purchased in 2019 and will be required again in 2021. Uniforms must be ordered before **June 21, 2020** to ensure a three week delivery. The following items are required to be purchased;

Premier/Elite/Select: \$110

- One (1) Adidas home jersey
- One (1) Adidas training jersey
- One (1) Adidas training short
- One (1) Adidas training socks
- One (1) Adidas size 3 ball
