Zoom meeting is being held tonight to discuss the issue of possible participation restrictions for our players if they travel out of state.

Situation: We have a competitive softball player was reported to be returning this week from 2 weeks of traveling to Puerto Rico and Florida. Is this player eligible to return to practice and compete in the tournament in Reedsburg this upcoming weekend? It was subsequently discovered that the player only spent time in Florida and has been in Chicago for the past 2 weeks.

Discussion was held by the members present, along with input from other members via email. The consensus from the group tonight was to not put any restrictions on team participation based on recent travel. The basis for this decision was that there currently are no guidelines from county, state or federal government entities about travel restrictions due to the Covid-19 virus. The MBSC does not have the resources or expertise to determine which areas of the country are COVID hot spots that should be avoided by our players and families. Any restrictions that we make would be very subjective and arbitrary.

Kelly will craft an email to MBSC families with several reminders about the COVID-19 situation, including the importance of following our social distancing and sanitization guidelines while at practices and games. Players, coaches and volunteers should not participate in any team activities if they are showing any COVID-19 symptoms. MBSC players must also inform their team coaches and league director if they test positive for COVID-19 or have been exposed to a confirmed COVID-19 case.

Mike suggests that the MBSC board should have a weekly Zoom meeting to communicate any updates on the COVID-19 situation, and how it might affect MBSC activities. Brian and Jamie will work to schedule these meetings.
