

MY7ON7 COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

CORE PRINCIPLES

- My7on7 Passing League's Coaches' participation must be healthy, positive and safe for everyone involved.
- The coach is the key to making the My7on7 experience positive, educational and fun. They foster a positive athletic experience for all participants including players, parents, officials, the opposing team and all fans.

CORE PRACTICES

AS A COACH I WILL:

- Conduct myself in a dignified manner relating to emotions, language, attitude and actions.
- Act at all times to protect the principles of fun, safety and development of all athletes.
- Demonstrate respect for the ability of opponents as well as for the judgment of referees, officials and opposing coaches.
- Display control and professionalism at all times under any circumstance.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person, including opponents, other coaches, officials, administrators, parents, athletes, and spectators.
- Refrain from physical contact with athletes except where necessary for the development of the athletes' skill(s) or athletic ability.
- Be aware and understand the role and influence of a coach as an educator, imparting knowledge of skill as well as proper personal, academic, and social behavior.
- Be reasonable in my demands on athletes' time, energy and enthusiasm.
- Provide an opportunity for all athletes to play the sport.

PLAYER SAFETY

- Coaches will ensure safety best practices are followed for their specific sport. This includes proper use of protective equipment, safe techniques, adequate breaks/hydration and limiting or canceling practices due to heat/weather conditions.
- Coaches will remove players from practice or competition when injured and not allow players to return until determined safe to do so. Doctor release required for concussions and other serious injuries.
- Coaches will become familiar with and adhere to:
 - Concussion Policy
 - Player Code of Conduct Policy
 - Abuse/Molestation Risk Management Program
 - Background Check Policy (coaches required to report to My7on7 newly occurring offenses/misdemeanors/felonies outlined in policy)
- Federal/state law requires coaches/managers/staff who has a suspicion of child sexual or physical abuse to independently report such suspicion directly to law enforcement within 24 hours. Failure to report may be a punishable offense. Reporting is also required to My7on7.
