Cypress Youth Baseball Members,

In 2020, the city of Cypress remodeled the Oak Knoll Park bathrooms and snack bar. While the bathrooms were available for use in the 2021 spring season, the snack bar was not. The snack bar is in the final stages of obtaining the appropriate permits to reopen for the 2021 fall season. After obtaining the permits, in order for the snack bar to officially reopen, we must have volunteers to sign up for shifts for the fall season. The snack bar will be open on Sundays between 10am - 4pm for the fall season. The shifts are in 3 hours increments. Snack bar sign ups will open on 9/9/2021. While we are waiting for approvals, CYB will have an outdoor snack area selling limited items for the games on 9/12/2021.

New regulations are in place for people to work inside the snack bar. In order to work in the snack bar, every person must have a food handler card. The card is \$7.95, valid for 3 years, and accepted throughout California, except for Riverside, San Bernardino and San Diego Counties.
