

Burnett Youth Hockey Association Meat Raffle Instructions

Raffle starts at 6:30, but often times, people don't start showing up until 6:45-7:00. The owners of Whitetail Wilderness ask that we wait until 7:00 to call off the meat raffle due to there being too few people. While waiting, please do the money round (round 1). Sell tickets for the money round shortly after 6:30-6:55. You will then have a good idea of how many people are there to participate in the meat raffle. If it is still too slow at 7:00 (less than 10-12 people participating in the raffle), then you can call the meat raffle off. Please announce that there aren't enough participants for the evening. Thank those that participated in the money round and hopefully we will see them next week.

Tickets are \$1.00 each or 7 tickets for \$5.00

Microphone: The microphone will be with the other meat raffle items on the shelf back by the ATM. Please **welcome and thank everyone for coming out to the meat raffle sponsored by the Burnett Youth Hockey Association. All proceeds go to support our youth hockey program.** During each round, when selling tickets, announce what **round we are on, the ticket price and do a last call for tickets** if the bar is pretty busy. When drawing, announce the **winning ticket numbers (the last 4 digits should suffice)**. When everything is done, please make sure to **thank Whitetail Wilderness for hosting and thank everyone for participating and supporting the Burnett Youth Hockey Association.** Feel free to do all of this in your own words, just wanted to provide a basic script if needed.

Rounds:

Round 1: 50/50 Money Round--Split the money collected (anything over the \$100 change in the blue money bag) in half and give one-half to the winning ticket holder. Put the other half in the green money bag (the money bag that holds the money to purchase meat and gift cards), so that it isn't included in the next money round.

Round 2: Meat and Drink Round--There will be 10 drawings in this round: 5 for meat (\$20 gift card to Whitetail is counted towards the meat drawing) and 5 for a free drink from the bar. There should be 4 meats, 1 \$20 gift card and 5 drink tickets left after this round to be used in round 4. Before starting the next round, move any money in the blue bag over \$100 to the green bag so that you can start fresh for the next round.

Round 3: 50/50 Money Round--Same as round 1: Split the money collected (anything over the \$100 change in the blue money bag) in half and give one-half to the winning ticket holder. Put the other half in the green money bag (the money bag that holds the money to purchase meat and gift cards).

Round 4: Meat and Drink Round--There will be 10 drawings in this round: 5 for meat (\$20 gift card to Whitetail is counted towards the meat drawing) and 5 for a free drink from the bar. When done drawing the 10 tickets, make sure to leave \$100 change in the blue change bag (keep a lot of \$5's, some \$10's and some \$1's to make change for the next weekend) (this is optional, can be done at a later time if need be). Put the remaining money in the green bag.

Please return the cooler to Fourwinds Market and the money bags to the hockey rink--concessions, 2nd drawer down below the cash register (preferably by Monday night practice)--if you are unable to return the money bags or the cooler as requested, please post in the Hockey Moms United message board so that we are aware of what needs to be done before the next meat raffle.

*Fill out 1 volunteer form per skater (if 2+ people showed up to the meat raffle for the same skater, then it counts as 1 raffle toward your required meat raffles). Once you are done with your required meat raffles, the hours go toward regular volunteer hours.
