1. Roll Call - L. Doko Meeting called to order at 6:34PM PDT | 7:34PM MDT by Commissioner Adam Marfice. Attendance as noted: Ammon, CdA, ICA, Idaho Falls, Jackson Hole, Lake City, Logos School, Magic Valley, Mead, Pocatello, Sandpoint, Spokane Valley, Sun Valley and Teton Valley (14 of 14 teams present)

2. Approve October 2024 Minutes - L.Doko Nate Rolston made the 1st motion to approve; Nathan Kanning (IHSLLE Division Director - North) made the 2nd motion to approve; all teams present voted unanimously on approving the October 9th, 2024 meeting minutes.

3. Treasurer Report - N. Gray \$7,653 ending October balance; \$4 TEAMS and \$1,049 SportsEngine renewal paid; \$650 insurance due 1/2025.

4. New ILOA Awards - A. Marfice These new awards are voted by ILOA officials.

- The 'Bob Durland' Official of the Year Award. This award is given to officials who exemplify integrity and professionalism on and off the field while acknowledging deviation and performance in lacrosse officiating; it has been awarded to Joshua Burkart.
- Road Warrior Award. This award honors an official whose extraordinary commitment to the sport that truly stands out; it has been awarded to Mike Donnelly.
- Sportsmanship Award (IHSLLE area) This award is given to a single league high school team that best exemplifies the ideals of sportsmanship and respect for the game of lacrosse. This award honors teams that consistently demonstrate integrity, respect for opponents and officials, and a commitment to uploading the spirit of the game; it has been awarded to Logos School Knights.

5. New IHSLLE Team - A. Marfice Nick Browneller shared he is fielding a new high school boys team in Rexburg, and has approximately 17 players recruited to date. He has been spreading the word throughout the area and has secured indoor practice facilities. The membership voted unanimously in favor to accept Rexburg as a new club in the Eastern Division of IHSLLE.

6. Bylaw/Policy Revisions - A. Marfice

- Presentation of Bylaw/Policy revisions Membership was emailed a copy of the proposed Bylaw/Policy Revisions for review.
- IHSLLE Policies - Proposed Changes
 - SECTION I – GENERAL POLICIES B. Player Assignment: This revision is being developed to ensure fairness, address the new state boundary between Idaho and Washington and to ultimately avoid player poaching.

 - ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP - Section 3: Member Dues
 - ARTICLE VIII - MEETINGS - Section 2: Required Coach Attendance
- IHSLLE membership vote Membership unanimously voted in favor of adopting the Bylaw/Policy revisions. Spokane Valley noted the revisions will impact 5-6 players next spring (2026) who have been playing lacrosse together since age 5+, and their ability to continue playing on the same team.
