## **Sec 19:**

#4 plays to #2 in the smallest part of the field and should have easily used #1. #2 is able to get the ball to #6 because of bad defending, #6 CHANGES THE POINT OF ATTACK which opens up space to attack forwards.

## **Min 4:**

#1 plays very predictably into high block press from the opponents two times in a row. In order to have success here the #1 must vary his distribution and be deceptive by showing a decoy action/pump fake away from the player who will receive the ball, very inch matters when building out from the back. Sometimes it is best for #1 to skip a line with a direct flighted pass into a forward, the reaction from the opponent next will be to drop off which creates space to build attack again.

## **Min 8:**

#4 receives the ball with his back to goal and with big of space between he and the #1. A negative pass to #1 here would allow the team to find there set team posture, maintain a controlled tempo of play and retain the ball.

## **Min 13.25:**

A throw in from the #3 results in a turnover in a dangerous area of the field. #8, #10 and #11 all need to get away from the ball to stretch the defense and created gaps to check into. They also need to find balance so that after the throw the 1st attacker has multiple passing solutions. Done properly in Min 56.55

## **Min 29.35:**

#1 shows the team that he wants to play direct by waiving his arms forward. The team has no reaction and are stretched when the distribution goes resulting in a turnover. All player on the field need to shift and get compact around the location of where the ball will arrive in order to have a surplus of players and win the second ball from an aerial dual.

## **Min 51:30**

On this goal kick the #6 pushes way high up the field. The team is left without a central to player to build an attack and when the distribution is played long there is a huge hole in the most dangerous area of the field leaving the team vulnerable to a counter-attack
