CCM/Minnesota Hockey High Performance Girls 15s

District 4 and 9 invite you to try out for the 2026 CCM/Minnesota Hockey High Performance Girls 15's. The purpose of the CCM High Performance Program is to identify, train, educate and evaluate Minnesota's best hockey players. The competition throughout the program gives each player the opportunity to measure themselves against others in her age group, gain knowledge about her development and to be exposed to outstanding coaching. Players (including High School players) in Districts 4 and 9 who were born in **2011** are eligible to try-out.

Phase 1 Try-Outs:

Try-outs: @ All Seasons Arena in Mankato, MN.

- Session 1: Wednesday, March 18th- 7:30pm- 8:45pm
- Session 2: Monday, March 23rd- 6:00pm -7:00pm
- Session 3: Saturday March 28th- 12:45pm-2:00pm
 - Goalies Only- Saturday, March 28th- 11:30am-12:30pm

The try-out fee is **\$120**. Players will be issued a tryout jersey that **must be returned**. Complete online registration fee, player profile, and consent to treat form at:

Online registration is available now. Fees and forms must be paid and completed before the 1st session.

Phase 2, Skills Sessions:

Approximately 30 players will be selected from the District 4/9 tryout and will be invited to ten additional hours of skills training sessions that will take place @ All Seasons Arena in Mankato. The fee for these sessions is **\$250**. This fee will also be paid online at the above Minnesota Hockey website address.

Phase 3, Spring Festival:

At the conclusion of the skills training sessions, the top 20 players from District 4 and 9 will be selected to participate in the Spring Festival. The fee for the team will be **\$350**. This fee will also be paid online at the above Minnesota Hockey website address. The roster of 20 players may have a practice prior to the Spring 15 festival. Alternates will be named in case a selected player is unable to participate. Players selected will receive a game jersey and socks.

The team will then play two preliminary games at Fogerty Arena, in Blaine, between April 13-23, 2026. They will then play three games in the Spring Festival, played at Doug Wood Arena in South St, Paul, between April 24-26, 2026.

Phase 4. Development Camp:

Following the Spring Festival, 102 players will be selected to attend the Phase 4 Minnesota Camp to be held at St Olaf College in Northfield on **June 9-14, 2026**. The Fee for those that are selected will be **\$750**.

Phase 5: USA Hockey National Girls Select 15 Development Camp

July 22 - 24, 2026, for Goalies & July 24 - 29, 2026 for Skaters in Oxford, OH

***Please remember if you are not a member of USA Hockey you must register online at <http://www.usahockey.com/> (click on players, then click "online registration"). You will not be able to skate until you are registered and forms are completed. Referee registrations are not valid.*

The toughest assignment the coaching staff/evaluators will face during the entire process is the player evaluation process. Selecting players is not a perfect science and there isn't a perfect method that assures that we will always select the best player. We recognize that and we understand the disappointment of being passed over for another player. The best we can hope for is to give the selection process our fullest attention.

If you advance from the try-out process and make the team, congratulations! If you aren't selected, we hope you will do what all dedicated athletes do: prepare, train, do all you can, and be ready the next time opportunity knocks!
