- Entry Form: Register athletes and coaches on USA Gym Meet Reservation system. There will be a \$100 per coach onsite registration charge.
- Entry Fee(s): Entry fee is \$135 per gymnast. ALL fees must be paid for at State meet on Meet Maker. Please make sure you have an account set up on Meet Maker prior to State Meet.
Level 8 gymnasts receiving a 34.00+AA at their state meet and intend to compete at regionals, must be paid for on entry.
Event Specialists must also be paid for on entry.
- Equipment: AAI Elite Equipment and boards at each event
Modified Capital Cup for all sessions.
- Age Groups: Age groups are set nationally by USA Gymnastics for Level 9/10. They will be available prior to state meets and posted on the regional website.
- Schedule: Schedule by age groups will be posted on the regional website.

Petition Form: If you need to petition an athlete, please visit the following website for instructions and procedures. New petition procedures are attached.

Coaches Packets: Packets will be available at the scoring table.

USAG Cards: You will be asked to show your current USAG Pro-member card at sign-in. Please be prepared to show identification and your USAG card.

Scores: Scores will be posted following completion of each session and available online.

Awards: Individual and All-Around awards will be presented to each Age Group following each competitive session. There will also be team awards given to the top 3 state teams at each level. Awards will follow the rules and policies requirements but will go out at least 40% in each age group as dictated by the regional board.

IMPORTANT: Western and National Qualifiers: ALL gymnasts and coaches qualifying for Western Championships or Nationals MUST be sized for official Region IV Apparel.

*Gymnasts need to be sized immediately following their competitive session.

*Coaches must be sized by 5:00pm on Saturday, April 17, 2021.

*Sizing area is behind awards area.

REMINDER! ALL Western and National qualifiers need to fill out the entry packet in full and return to the scoring table with payment.

**Failure to register and pay could result in your athletes not being registered for the competitions.*
