COMPETITION

- We are almost at the implementation phase. Next week we are going to bring a group together.
- 4 registrars have agreed to help us do some beta testing. Then we will bring the registers in next week. We will provide training on how to use the system, and they're going to do some beta testing for us by entering teams and making changes. We will go through some of the typical mechanics that we do during the regular season and make sure everything's working right. We expect the system to be implemented in May.
- We are looking to have a registrars training session either May 6th or 13th. Associations Presidents will be invited as well.
