Reports:

New Business: Mindy

Currently there are 2 spectators allowed per player at each game and concessions are not allowed. On May 19 a decision regarding state playoffs for spring sports will be announced. If playoffs are approved the county will drop its playoffs and teams will go directly to the state playoffs.

Cliff met with Seth Adams, the head of construction for MCPS. It was decided that since graduation is June 4, on June 7 all items will be removed from the press box and it will be demoed. A new press box will not be installed since the school is slated for a renovation in 2025. A temporary press box will be placed on the roof of the school. A science closet will be converted to a stairway with access to the roof and the temporary press box which will be used until the remodel is complete. Construction on the remodel is set to start in the fall of 2025 and the stadium will be used as a staging area.
