

## 2020 IFalls Rec Hockey Preparedness Plan COVID-19 Restrictions

### **Masks are required to be worn by all people while in the arenas – MN State Governor's Order.**

The following arena restrictions have been assigned by the arena's State and local City government agencies. These policies are defined by the arena and our local governing bodies and are in place to protect all people attending the rinks for any reason. Please note that this is subject to change.

#### Kerry Park Arena

- 👤 All players, coaches, referees and minor officials going on the ice will be responsible to self-monitor their health and any participant showing signs of illness will be asked to leave the facility. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 degrees should not enter the facility.
- 👤 Hand sanitizer will be available, and it is expected that everyone sanitizes their hands upon entry and exit of the building.
- 👤 Masks are required while in the building, except when on the ice. Coaches are encouraged to wear a mask on the bench.
- 👤 All players must bring their own water bottles from home, filled and clearly marked with their name.
- 👤 No use of public drinking fountains.
- 👤 No handshake line, high fives or goalie celebrations. Teams are encouraged to do a stick salute to one another on their respective lines after the game.
- 👤 Follow signage and flow of the building to avoid cross traffic.
- 👤 Always maintain social distancing, except when on the ice.
- 👤 Only enter the building 15 minutes before your ice time.
- 👤 Come to the rink in full equipment, skates, helmets and gloves may be put on in the rink.
- 👤 Players must leave within 10 minutes of the end of their practice/game.
- 👤 Use assigned locker rooms only when required and stay with the group you shared the locker room with. Players must stay in the designated area/locker room until it is time to go on the ice.
- 👤 Coaches must stay with team in designated area/locker room and be sure guidelines are followed.
- 👤 For games, 2 parents/spectators per player may enter the building 5 minutes prior to game time and are expected to exit immediately after the games. We ask that siblings do not attend. They must wear a mask in the facility and stay socially distanced inside the building.
- 👤 For practices, 1 parent/guardian per player will be allowed for the mini/mighty mite levels if needed. It is strongly encouraged that this age group comes with skates on.
- 👤 Spectators should not gather in the lobby pre or post game.
