COVID-19 RETURN TO PLAY RESPONSIBILITIES

PLAYER

- If you are not feeling well, stay home!
- Maintain proper social distancing when feasible – game play is allowed.
- Water and personal equipment should not be shared.
- Wearing a mask is required at all times indoors or outdoors
- Player bags and equipment should be spaced apart on the sideline.
- Pack hand sanitizer to use before and after training.
- Get on and off the fields as quickly as possible to prevent excess contact between inbound and outbound players.
- Bring your own soccer ball and water.
- Do not touch communal equipment (cones, nets, etc.)

PARENT/GUARDIAN

- If you think your player is sick, keep them home! If a coach has a concern about your player's health, you will be asked to pick up your player.
- Spectators should maintain proper social distancing on the sidelines.
- Do not drop players off more than 10 minutes early to practice.
- Pack hand sanitizer in your player(s) bag.
- Encourage your player to get on and off the fields as quickly as possible to prevent excess contact between inbound and outbound players.
- Email president@bysamn.org with any questions or concerns or if your player tests positive for COVID-19.

COACHES

- If you feel sick, stay home!
- Disinfect shared equipment before and after training.
- Maintain proper social distancing when feasible – game play is allowed.
- Wearing a mask is required at all times indoors or outdoors
- Monitor water breaks to ensure social distancing.
- Ensure that player bags are spaced apart on the sideline.
- Use hand sanitizer before, and after training.
- Encourage players to get on and off the fields as quickly as possible.
- Limit handing out equipment and do not allow the players to share.
- If pinnies are used during practice, they must be washed before they are used again.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- Will have masks available for coaches if needed.
- Will have hand sanitizer available for each coach to be used on player hands and equipment before, and after training (if individual players do not have their own).
- Board Members may patrol the fields to assure everyone is safe and following the social distancing guidelines.
- Answer any questions or direct members to who they should contact with questions.
