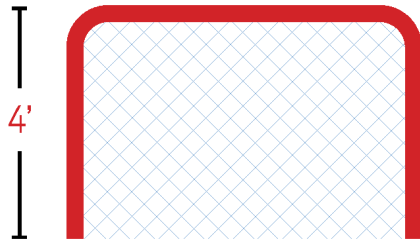

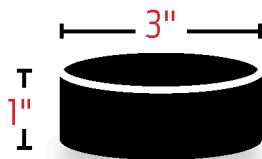

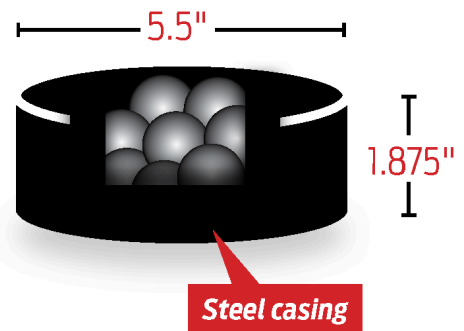
A three-foot net is used instead of a four-foot net and goalies have to be fully blind or blindfolded



BIGGER PUCK



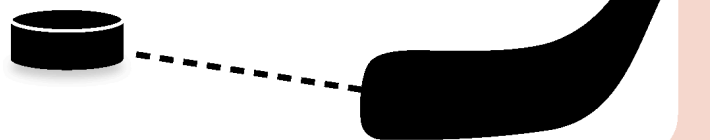
The puck is 3 times the size and has 8 ball-bearings inside to make noise

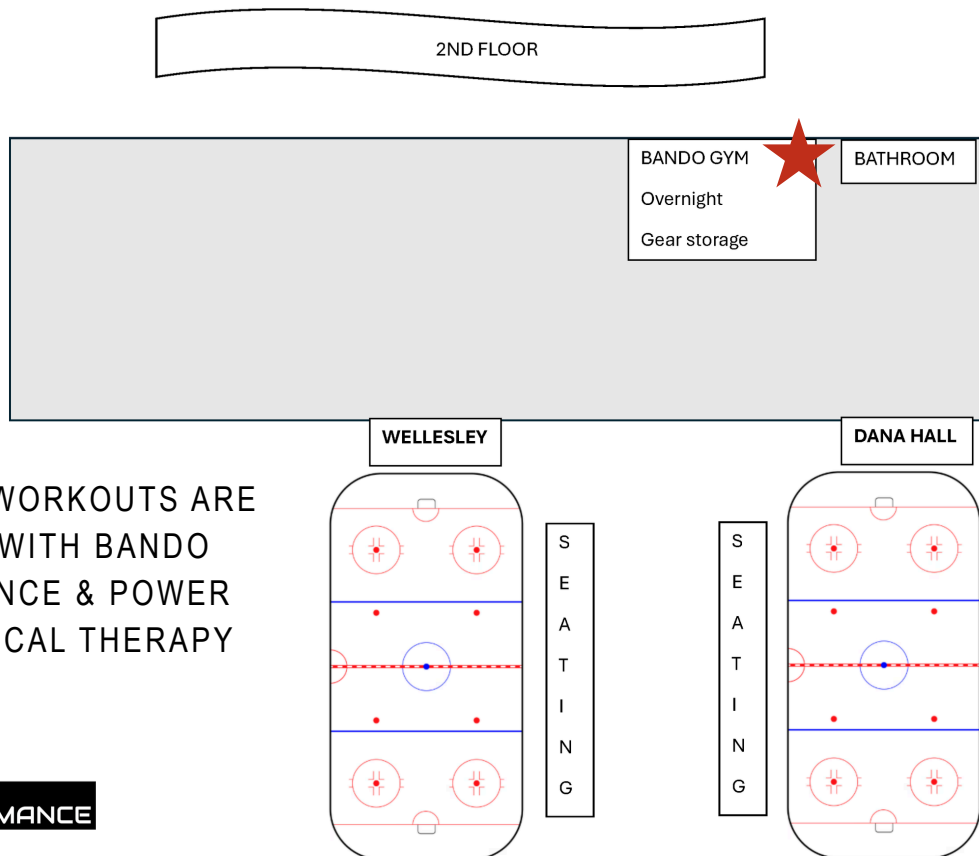
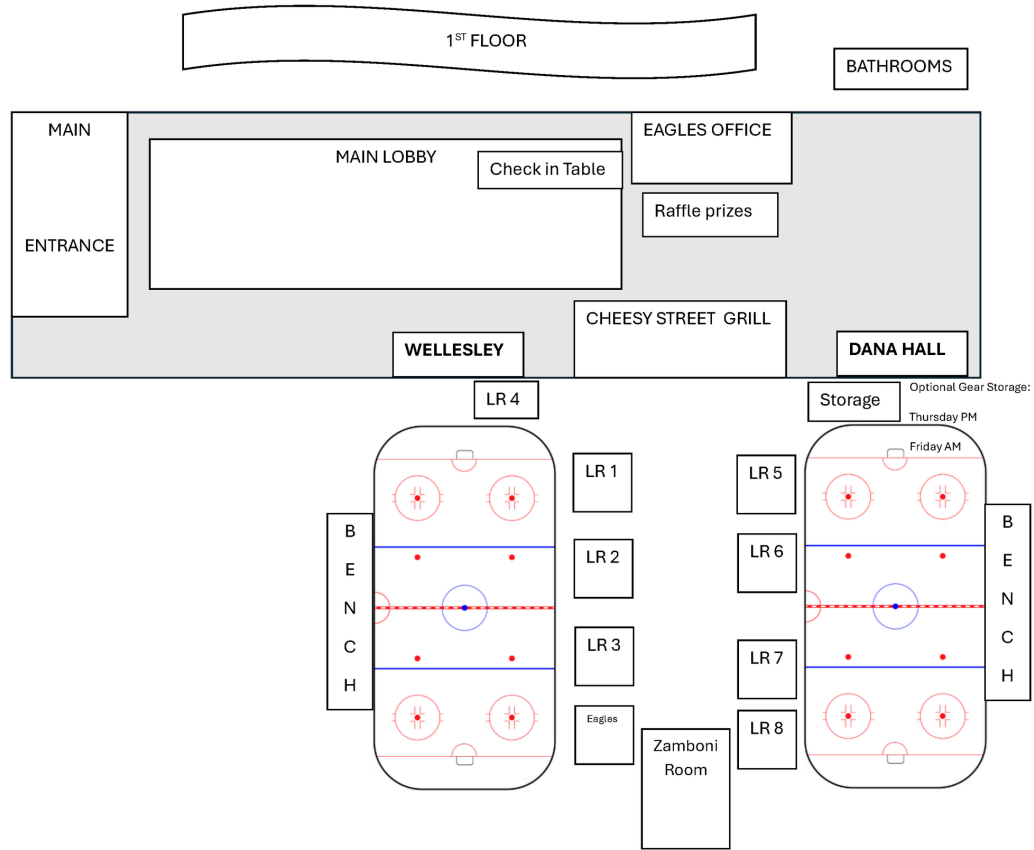

INFORMATION

Player Check in:

When teams arrive, they will find a check-in table located by the stairs in the hallway leading to the main registration area. A representative from USA Hockey will be onsite to assist and confirm each team's check-in.

Team check-in will begin on **Friday, November 21 at 1:00 PM.**

Equipment Storage:

All players can store their equipment throughout the weekend on the 2nd floor of the Boston Sports Institute in the Bando gym. National Players can leave their equipment outside of the Dana Hall rink.

Game Format:

White and Red Divisions

- 5 Minute Warm up
- 15 Minute Periods
- Running clock in 1st and 2nd periods, stop time in 3rd period

Blue Division

- 30 Minutes skills training
- 30 Minutes cross ice games
- Full ice game on Sunday with running time

All rostered players, coaches and volunteers will receive a free ticket, Tickets will be required and extra tickets for friends and families are available for purchase for \$25.
