2021 HEALTH AND WELLNESS PLAN – COVID 19 PROTOCOLS

GAME DAY SAFETY PROTOCOLS

BEFORE ENTRY TO THE FACILITY/PARK:

- ALL PLAYERS MUST FILL OUT THE ONLINE QUESTIONNAIRE PRIOR TO ENTRY TO HSP
- ALL FANS MUST FILL OUT THE PAPER QUESTIONNAIRE PRIOR TO ENTRY TO HSP
- TAKE YOUR TEMPERATURE PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT THE FACILITY/PARK. ANY PLAYER/FAN WITH A TEMPERATURE AT OR ABOVE THE CDC RECOMMENDED TEMPERATURE (100.4) ARE REQUIRED TO STAY HOME AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE FACILITY/PARK.
- MASKS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED WHEN ARE YOU NOT ABLE TO MAINTAIN A SAFE SOCIAL DISTANCE (AT LEAST 6') FROM OTHERS. ACCEPTABLE MASKS INCLUDE SURGICAL MASKS, CLOTH MASKS, AND GAITERS. FACE COVERING MUST COVER, FULLY, THE FACE AND MOUTH.
- BEFORE DEPARTING TO THE FACILITY/PARK, EACH PLAYER/FAN MUST ANSWER “NO” TO THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS, IN ADD ADDITION TO THE TEMPERATURE CHECK:
 - HAVE YOU BEEN TOLD TO QUARANTINE OR SELF-ISOLATE BY A PHYSICIAN OR GOVERNMENT AGENCY DUE TO COVID 19?
 - HAVE YOU HAD CONTACT WITH A POSITIVE OR SUSPECT-POSITIVE COVID 19 INDIVIDUAL(S) IN THE PAST 14 DAYS?
 - ARE YOU EXPERIENCING ANY COVID 19 SYMPTOMS THAT CANNOT BE ATTRIBUTED TO ANOTHER HEALTH CONDITION?

ONCE INSIDE THE FACILITY/PARK:

- ALL PLAYERS AND FANS MUST WEAR A MASK WHILE NOT ACTIVELY EATING OR DRINKING.
- MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN POSSIBLE AND LIMIT CONGREGATION AND GROUP GATHERINGS, ESPECIALLY INDOORS
- WASH YOUR HANDS AND UTILIZE HAND SANITIZER REGULARLY
- COVER COUGHS AND SNEEZES
- CLEAN AND DISINFECT FREQUENTLY TOUCHED OR SHARED SURFACES REGULARLY
- LIMIT OR AVOID CONTACT WITH OTHERS
- DO NOT SHARE FOOD OR BEVERAGE PRODUCTS WITH OTHERS. NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK ARE ALLOWED INTO HSP

ONCE INSIDE THE FIELD/DUGOUT:

- LIMIT THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN THE DUGOUT. ONLY ROSTERED TEAM MEMBERS ARE PERMITTED IN THE DUGOUT AND MASKS ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN WHEN INSIDE THE DUGOUT.
- HAND SANITIZER WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE LSC IN EACH DUGOUT
- AT THE START OF THE GAME, THE COACH OR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE MUST WEAR A MASK WHEN VISITING WITH THE UMPIRE. THE UMPIRE WILL PROVIDE EACH TEAM WITH A NEW BALL TO USE WHILE ON DEFENSE. IF A BALL GOES OUT OF PLAY, A NEW BALL WILL BE PROVIDED OR THE EXISTING BALL MUST BE SANITIZED BEFORE USE.

- PAS BATS WILL BE TREATED WITH A 24HR ANTI-BACTERIAL SPRAY PRIOR TO PLAY EACH DAY. SPRAY WILL BE PROVIDED IN THE DUGOUTS SHOULD ANY TEAM DESIRE TO SPRAY THEM AGAIN. IF YOU SPRAY THE BATS, PLEASE ALLOW 5 MINUTES FOR THE TREATMENT TO SET BEFORE USING.
- THE UMPIRE AND CATCHER ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK WHILE ON THE FIELD OF PLAY. ALL BATTERS MUST WEAR A MASK WHILE AT BAT. PLAYERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO WEAR A MASK WHILE ON THE BASE PATHS.
- BASE COACHES ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK WHILE IN THE FIELD OF PLAY
- MASKS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED FOR ALL OTHER COACHES, FIELDERS AND BASERUNNERS
- BATTING GLOVES SHOULD NOT BE SHARED AND ARE RECOMMENDED FOR ALL BATTERS. BATTERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SANITIZE THEIR HANDS BEFORE AND AFTER BATTING
- TEAM HUDDLES SHOULD BE LIMITED AND DISTANCED
- HIGH FIVE LINES ARE NOT PERMITTED AFTER THE GAME.
- SINGLE SCOREKEEPING SHEETS WILL BE PROVIDED, AND TEAM SHOULD PROVIDE THEIR OWN WRITING INSTRUMENT. WE ENCOURAGE TEAMS TO BRING/PROVIDE A WRITING SURFACE (CLIPBOARD) FOR THE SCORING SHEET.

LSC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MODIFY THE HEALTH AND WELLNESS PLAN AND ANY OTHER PROTOCOLS/PROCEDURES, AS NEEDED.

LSC PLAYERS AND FANS ARE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES AND PROTOCOLS ESTABLISHED BY MSLA AND LSC, THE FACILITY/PARK AND THOSE OF REGIONAL AND GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN INDIVIDUAL AND/OR TEAM CONSEQUENCES.
