



Snowplow Sam- Basic 6 Basic Elements Program Format (Compulsory Program)

For levels Snowplow Sam-Basic 6, the compulsory program will follow this format:

1. After warm up, all skaters in their group will be announced and they will enter the ice as a group and stand in line on the ice IN THEIR SKATE ORDER.
2. Numbers will be taped on the boards. Each skater will stand by their skate order number until they are called forward and then return to their number after performing each element.
3. The first element will be announced AND then demonstrated by a senior club skater.
4. One at a time, as their name is called by the senior club skater, the skater will come forward off the boards and will perform only THAT element for the judges.
5. When the skater has completed that element, they will return to their number on the boards.
6. The senior club member will wait until the judges give the "okay" before calling the next skater forward to perform the element.

7. This will be repeated for each required element.
8. Each element will only be skated once or the amount of times stated in the list of elements for their level.
9. After the skaters have skated all the required elements, they will leave the ice together as one group.
10. NO MUSIC.
11. ELEMENTS WILL BE SKATED ONE AT A TIME IN THE ORDER LISTED
12. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the ice will be used.
