KICKOFF NOTES

- A first place showdown in Nanaimo as the VI Raiders (5-2) host the Okanagan Sun (4-2-1) at 2:30pm on Saturday
- The Langley Rams host the Kamloops Broncos on Saturday night after the resignation of head coach Matt Snoop Blokker citing health reasons. GM Howie Zaron takes over
- A massive game on Saturday afternoon in Chilliwack where the Valley Huskers host the Westshore Rebels. The winner puts a hold on the final playoff spot
- Just four CJFL games on Saturday, then five are set for Sunday
- The Edmonton Huskies make their first visit to Saskatoon since the 2015 season
- Oddly enough both Edmonton teams are on the road, while Clarke Stadium sits empty
- The Regina Thunder could be the most dangerous 2-3 in the CJFL and will host the Edmonton Wildcats who are trying to get to three wins
- It's déjà vu all over again with all three Ontario Conference match-ups enter the second half of their home and home
- Hamilton Hurricanes quarterback Jake Marquette as thrown for an incredible 22 touchdown through the first six games compared to just one interception
- The Winnipeg Rifles will play at Investors Group Field for the first time this season when they host the Calgary Colts
- The Valley Huskers, Windsor AKO Fratmen and Regina Thunder will play their final home game of the regular season
- Entering Week 9 of the CJFL season the Okanagan Sun have the best takeaway to giveaway ratio with an amazing +21. They have recovered 16 fumbles and intercepted 14 passes
- Okanagan Sun linebacker Conor Richard has four blocked kicks this season, the most since 2008 when Hamilton Hurricanes linebacker Aram Eisho hit that mark. The CJFL single season record for blocked kicks is held by Kameron Taylor of the Kamloops Broncos in 2007

WEEK 8 REWIND**Ontario Conference**

Windsor AKO Fratmen: #18 Dante Lewis ran back a punt return for 100 yards and a touchdown against GTA.

Hamilton Hurricanes: #29 Angus Button gets entered into the CJFL Record Book for catching 4 TD's in the game with the Raiders, having 7 receptions for 176 yards. The quarterback throwing to Angus and his teammates was **#3 Jake Marquette** who was 14 for 15 for 323 yards and 6 TD's.

Prairie Conference

Saskatoon Hilltops: #38 Josh Ewanchyna, RB, just keeps going! He had 18 carries for 168 yards and 1 TD against the Thunder.

Edmonton Huskies: #1 Oshane Samuels, also gets entered into the CJFL Record Book for 2 blocked kicks in the win over the Rifles. He had 20 defensive points, as did **#10 Justin Hodinsky,** while **#5 Harrison Cabel** had 5 receptions for 115 yards and a TD.

Calgary Colts: #17 Dallas Burke had 5 receptions for 117 yards and a touchdown on the road vs. the Wildcats

British Columbia Conference

Okanagan Sun: #28 Kelton Kouri, RB, ran for 140 yards and a TD on 10 carries – one of them being for 100 yards – against the Huskers. On defense, **#7 Jordan Rae** had 20 points.

Langley Rams: #2 Maximillian Joseph had the best day in the CJFL this year, running 24 times for 226 yards and 3 TD's, including a 93 yarder against the Rebels.

Valley Huskers: #2 Brandon Poulin had 9 receptions against the Rams for 124 yards, and **#21 Remis Tshiovo** returned a punt 25 yards for a TD.
