11.02 Coaching Certification

BCMBA Post-Season, Coaches and Manager Certification

<TABLE NO CHANGES>

All Coaches – Safe Sport eLearning is mandatory.

Westerns and Nationals Certification: Teams travelling to Western Canadian or National Championships must have the prescribed number of certified field staff as defined by Baseball Canada. Failure to have this certification will result in BCMBA, in conference with the affected association, replacing non-certified field staff with certified field staff.

Note: Zones are defined as any series of games that leads to the Provincials, Westerns or Nationals

NCCP training requirements are to be completed with the following timelines and expectations.

Single Season

(13UAAA, 15UAA, 15UAAA, 18UAAA, 18UCP)

April 1st - all coaches must be In Training. In Training is defined as two online modules (Coach Initiation in Sport, Coach Initiation in Baseball), and any one NCCP course required for the division.

June 1st - all coaches must have met completed NCCP Requirements for the division.

Summer Season

(13UAA, 18UAA)

June 15th - all requirements must be met by June 15th as per rule 9.08

(10U, 11UA, 11UAA, 11UAAA, 13UA, 15UA)

July 1st - all coaches must have met completed NCCP Requirements for the division.

Failure to comply with training requirements will result in the coach being ineligible to be on the field.
