### **About SD & Seaside Volleyball Club**

San Diego Volleyball Club was the first girl's volleyball club in San Diego. Established in 1986, it has been a part of the community for more than 38 years. As we approach our 19th season in our 4S Ranch facility, we proudly continue to teach volleyball skills, teamwork and self-esteem, in the spirit of competition to our many participants.

In 2009, SDVBC proudly welcomed Seaside VBC into our volleyball family as our boys program. Founded in 1989, Seaside was the 1st boy's club in San Diego. Seaside has continued to be one of the top boy's clubs in Southern California and is the only boys club in San Diego to win a national championship, 4 of them in fact.

### **About SD & Seaside Volleyball Club: Work Play Program**

The Work Play Program at San Diego & Seaside Volleyball Club provides players and families with financial need the opportunity for a part time position within the Club in order to earn credit towards their Club Fees. The positions available are integral to the Club's overall operations and success, so we ask that players and families take their commitment to the Work Play Program seriously.

## **Available Assignments: Position Descriptions**

### **Referee for Local Tournaments:**

**Description:** Referees will be in charge of officiating all matches assigned to the court from the ref stand. Referees will officiate each match in the pool assigned to the court and keep score. Referees will handle all on court decisions, and anything they cannot answer will be referred to the Tournament Director.

**Positions Available:** 60 Referees. Summer availability differs.

**Credit Earned:** \$25 credit per hour for players

**Qualifications:** Travel players on 14-18's SDVBC/Seaside teams (some exceptions may apply). Younger and local players may be approved for this position as well on a case by case basis. A good understanding of the game, ability to be in charge of everything on their court, ability to work with adults, ability to get on and off ref stands and a great attitude!

**Scheduling & Scope of Work:** Officiating shifts take place on tournament weekends, and depending on the tournament schedule can last from 3-4 hours each. Scheduling will be handled via the online SignUp form.

### **Parking Attendants for Local Tournaments:**

**Description:** Parking Attendants will be responsible for monitoring parking to ensure tournament patrons are parking in the appropriate spots and staying within SD/Seaside property.

**Positions Available:** 40 Parking Attendants. Summer availability differs.

**Credit Earned:** \$25 credit per hour for players and \$20 credit per hour for family members.

**Qualifications:** 15 years of age. Younger players may be approved for this position as well on a case by case basis. Professional, respectful, punctual and friendly. Can answer routine questions or direct to the correct person.

**Scheduling & Scope of Work:** Parking Attendant shifts take place during tournament weekends, and depending on the tournament schedule can last from 3-4 hours each. Scheduling will be handled via the online SignUp form.

## **Entry Attendants for Local Tournaments:**

**Description:** Entry Attendants will be responsible for collecting entry fees at the door for all spectators entering the tournament.

**Positions Available:** 45 Entry Attendants. Summer availability differs.

**Credit Earned:** \$25 credit per hour for players and \$20 credit per hour for family members.

**Qualifications:** Only adults (over 18 years of age) and players under 14 years of age accompanied by an adult (parent/guardian, not sibling) from their family are approved. Professional, respectful, punctual and friendly. Ability to count change. Can answer routine questions or direct to the correct person.

**Scheduling & Scope of Work:** Entry Attendant shifts take place during tournament weekends, and depending on the tournament schedule can last from 3-4 hours each. Scheduling will be handled via the online SignUp form.

## **Snack Shack Attendant**

**Description:** Snack Shack Attendants are integral to the successful operation of the Snack Shack and Local Tournaments. Attendants will be trained on all aspects of Snack Shack operations. The main scope of work for Attendants will take place in the Snack Shack, however they can expect other miscellaneous tournament responsibilities (ex: parking attendant, emptying trash cans as they fill up, etc.). Some Snack Shack responsibilities include greeting customers, taking orders/payments, basic food preparation, and cleaning/sanitizing.

**Positions Available:** 50 Attendant positions. Summer availability differs.

**Credit Earned:** \$25 credit per hour for players and \$20 credit per hour for family members.

**Qualifications:** Only players under 14 years of age accompanied by an adult (parent/guardian, not sibling) from their family are approved to work in the Snack Shack. Individual adults may be approved on a case by case basis. A willingness to work and a great attitude! Ability to bend, stoop, lift, push, or pull 25 lbs is ideal but not required.

**Scheduling & Scope of Work:** Snack Shack shifts take place during tournament weekends and each shift is approximately 3-4 hours. Scheduling will be handled via the online SignUp form.

## **Jump Start & Camps Assistant Coach**

**Description:** The Assistant Coaches will be assigned to a certain program and agreed upon schedule at the beginning of their assignment. The Assistant Coaches will work with The Head Coach of the program to assist during practices. Further expectations will be discussed during the initial Work Play meeting.

**Positions Available:** At most 25 Assistant Coaches (possibly more depending on The Club's offerings at the time). Summer availability differs.

**Credit Earned:** \$25 credit per hour

**Qualifications:** Travel players on 14's - 18's teams, or by special approval. Younger players may be approved for this position as well on a case by case basis. Prior experience babysitting, coaching, or working with children is preferred. Reliability and communication skills are key to this role.

**Scheduling & Scope of Work:** The Assistant Coaches will initially work with The Club's Representative to determine their overall schedule and will then communicate directly with the Head Coach of the program. The Assistant Coach will always work under the supervision of either the Head Coach or another Coach as determined by The Club. This role requires an additional code of conduct to be discussed, signed, and abided by throughout the season.
