COVID Information Sheet

General Information

- State of Minnesota has implemented a mask mandate for indoor facilities
- Staff, coaches, skaters, spectators **must wear a mask at all times**
- Water fountains are turned off
- Showers are turned off
- Hat Trick Café is closed
- No cash transactions at the front desk
- No skate sharpening
- No skate rental

When can a player or spectator enter the building?

- Skaters can enter the building 10 minutes before start of ice session
- Goalies can enter the building 10 minutes before start of ice session
- NO spectators allowed at this time

Do hockey players have to come dressed in their gear?

- Hockey players must come fully dressed (carry skates, gloves, helmet, stick)
- No hockey bags allowed in the building (if carrying a bag...you will be asked to return it to your vehicle)
- **Goalies – can bring bag into building**
- Figure skaters can bring in roller bags

Practice Time

- No spectators allowed in the building for practices
- One parent/guardian may accompany a skater 10 years of age and younger to the locker room and assist with hockey gear and or tie skates
- Once they have helped their skater, ask the parent/guardian to leave the building
- **MITE ONLY – one parent/guardian will be allowed to watch from bleacher area during the ice session**

Game Time – NO games allowed at this time – games resume January 14th

- Two spectators per skater allowed for games – WAITING FOR UPDATE – THIS COULD CHANGE
- Must enter the building at game time
- Strongly recommend no siblings, family members, or grandparents
- Must watch from bleacher area only

Locker Room Usage

- Wear mask always
- Teams must use assigned skate changing areas
- Two skate changing areas will be available per ice session
- If skate changing area is full – overflow to hallway or lobby to social distance

Exempt Mask Requests – No exemptions at this time
