- Improve the DIBS system to make sure there opportunities for everyone to fulfill their DIBS and increased the DIBS awarded to those that put in countless hours as Coaches, Team Managers and chair positions.

I am running for the board again because I feel there is still more to do to help make Mahtomedi Youth Hockey a Great experience for players, parents and coaches.
