## Baseball Booster Meeting Minutes

January 13, 2025

**Call Meeting to order:** 5:37 pm

**Secretary's Report:** Minutes from November 11th meeting were emailed.  
Motion made by Steph to accept the minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup> Kasey, all in favor, passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** 2026 Budget updated and read by Lisa A.  
Motion made by Casey to approve, 2<sup>nd</sup> Kasey, all in favor, passed.

**Coaches Report:** Bass still working on assistant JV coach options. Waiting to hear from Darren Georgakis.

Player of the game baseballs to be given with a Varsity win. Coaches will determine this player. Casey is checking to see if American Family will sponsor this. If not, we will order the balls out of our budget.

### OLD BUSINESS

#### **Man Cave Bingo Fundraiser:**

Casey brought in additional checks received which brought our grand total of event with all money's received before and after \$13,041.28!!! Casey printed out Thank you cards that we addressed and will mail out to our donators (cash and prizes). Casey, Steph and Lisa have them to mail.

\$100.00 Memorial donation to the Klos family was approved via text message string on 1/5/2026. Motion by Tara, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steph, all approved, motion carried. Check was written and given to the family by Tara.

### NEW BUSINESS

#### **Uniform order with Chippewa Valley:**

Motion made by Lisa, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Casey and unanimously approved to place order via text/e-mail string on 1/12/2026.

Updated invoice being sent that should include shipping but initial invoice was \$8050.00. Bass to contact students to get him their correct hat size (s/m or l/xl) before he places the hat order. Last year some hats were too big for some kids. Will get one white hat w/purple paw for each player. School pays for that. Bass also to reach out to new players to get their jacket size and see if any current players want to order another one or a larger size. Lisa will also include that in the parent e-mail and group me. Sounds like several want to get a larger size since the coats run 1-2 size smaller than their shirt size for guys with broad shoulders.

### **Meat Raffle Fundraiser**

Decided to do 7 rounds of meat, giving out 5 packages (each valued around \$20) each round and two 50/50 cash raffle rounds. Total of 9 rounds of sales. Each round of meat is essentially \$100 in cost to us. Steph gave Donnie around \$450 in gift cards to purchase meat. We will have about \$400 in meat expense on top of that, cost of tickets and possibly some gift cards for another raffle bucket item.

Overall cost for event should be less than \$600.

We will likely sell tickets:

1 for \$2.00

3 for \$5.00

7 for \$10.00.

You have 5 chances to win with those tickets each round.

We are going to do bucket raffles for the other prizes we have: coors light, busch light, lawn chair, "coaches wallet" of gift cards from local businesses, Packer Football, Treasure Island getaway. Those we will likely sell 20 for \$10.00 (possible arm length)

Lisa to order three different color tickets on amazon (bucket raffle, cash raffle and meat raffle)

Lisa Murphy & Lisa Acker will go around and try to collect \$10 gift cards from area bars, restaurants, etc that we didn't reach out to for man cave bingo. We will buy them if needed. \$100.00 max to spend.

Donnie has the buckets for the bucket raffle. Donnie will purchase the meat. Lisa communicated that we will need 35 packages valued around \$20.00.

Casey is redoing flyer and will get out to us. Will need to advertise on FB, send e-mail to families, put in group me, hang up signs around town, share on our own social media's and website.

Bass to get boys to volunteer again to sell the raffle tickets each round for all the things. Will be busier than with man-cave and their presence needs to be seen

### **Parent Meeting - February 16, 2026 @ 6:30 in the library at EHS**

Lisa putting on website. Need to put together e-mail for parents with all the updates and information on fundraisers, store, ordering, etc.

Bass handed out player/parent handbook for booster members to look over and get back to him with any suggestions.

### **Apparel website**

Casey and Steph plan to meet this week and get this organized. Store will be with Jill Sears (Designs by Jill)

Bass will get sizing to get coats ordered for new players after parent meeting and current players can order new ones if needed (they would pay for them). New players are covered by boosters. (X-Grain site has them at \$40 ea.) - Need jackets for all the new players, Bass will get these players names and sizes. Also order any replacement coats for coaches and current players. We will include info in that parent e-mail. Need to get this done ASAP so they have them before the season starts. We will collect payment from current players who already have a coat.

### **Youth Camps**

Dates, cost/collect payment, sign-up genius, advertising, etc.- Dates have been set. Lisa to finish up sign-up genius and set up a payment link on there to collect payment when they register. No refunds unless the date is cancelled. This will allow Bass to plan for player help and group participants by age.

Get this onto the website and FB. Bass will share with EBSA on Sunday at their meeting. This is for ages 8-14. Skills they work on will progress each week. \$20.00 per session. Total of 4 sessions. Lisa will update flyer from Bass and get to Tara for FB once Sign-up Genius is done.

### **Field improvement needs, field work day, etc.-**

Table for February agenda - Bass to keep us posted and likely have players and coaches do some work on the field as soon as they are able to get outside this spring. Some was done this fall but the field needs several loads of red rock. We have \$5000 in our budget for field repairs but field maintenance and assistant coaches pay is the purpose of our meat raffle.

Superintendent/AD to come to our **February meeting** to give a referendum presentation. Set the date for Wednesday, **February 18th at 5:30 at Sabes Loft**. Likely our last meeting before the season starts.

4. We will do two \$250.00 scholarships with the \$500 we have budgeted this year. Money would not be given until they have satisfactorily completed their first semester and show proof of grades to receive.
5. Bass doesn't want to be the one to decide so we are suggesting he remove the names from applications and the booster members can read through them and determine who will receive the scholarships. Any member with a senior will need to abstain from this.

Tara or Lisa talk with Deiss to make sure this is possible and how students are made aware of this scholarship.
