ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Richmond United Football Club (RUFC) will be awarding up to ten **\$1,000** scholarships to Grade 12 graduating athletes who are currently involved in an RUFC program as a player, coach, or referee.

In order for an application to be considered, candidates must complete the attached application form in full and return it along with all required information, documents and letters prior to **February 27th**.

All applications will be reviewed by a selection committee and recommendations will be made to the RUFC Board, based upon the applicant's participation in and/or contributions to RUFC programs as described above. **Excellence in playing will not be the only criteria considered when applications are evaluated.** The RUFC Board will provide final approval for the selected applicants.

Scholarships are conditional until such time the recipient provides proof of attendance at a post-secondary institution.

CRITERIA

The successful applicant must meet all of the following criteria:

- A minimum of four years as a Richmond soccer player.
- Current involvement in an RUFC program as a player, coach, or referee.
- Current residence in the City of Richmond.
- Academic standing of a minimum C+ average.
- Remains in good standing within RUFC and the broader Richmond community.

Complete applications must include all of the four following documents attached in one email:

1. Completed Scholarship Application Form (below).
2. A copy of your most recent school transcript.
3. A personal letter of application outlining reasons why you believe you are qualified to receive an RUFC Scholarship (max 300 words).
4. Two letters of reference (one must be from an RUFC coach, director, or volunteer).
