Season Information

We expect to participate in a full regular season with the CRHL at the Squirt and Pee wee levels. At the Bantam level, we have the option to participate in the CRHL, additional scrimmages, and/or tournaments based on interest and availability of players. Mites will have a standard season with 12 scrimmage weekends. New for the 2021-22 season, we are excited to participate in a 4 weekend Jamboree schedule at Squirt, Pee wee and Bantam levels for a total of 16 games. These will be competitive games at the B level. The proposed schedule for these weekends is 11/12-14 in Grand Junction, 12/3-5 in Durango, 1/21-23 at Home, and 2/11-12 in Summit. Additionally, on 2/13 there is an optional pond hockey tournament in Summit.

Registration

Registration will be open starting today through September 30th. Fees this year will be \$350 for Mite/Mini-Mite, \$1100 for Squirt/Pee wee, \$1000 for the Bantam tournament team, and Learn to Skate will be free. For the squirt, pee wee, and bantam levels use discount code Eagles21 before the end of August to receive a \$100 discount.

Scholarships

As in years past we have opened up the application for scholarship funds. We are requiring that everyone seeking scholarship funds this year to be registered first. The scholarship form will be open for the duration of the registration but you are encouraged to apply early. This will allow us to better plan for the season in advance and assess the needs of our community.
