



2018-2019 LEGENDS BASEBALL 13U TRYOUT & INFORMATION:

The Legends Baseball Club is a 501(c)3 non-profit registered with a Tax ID of 38-3924229. Our mission is to provide a competitive baseball experience for the youth of Monroe and the greater community. We strive to provide baseball players ages 8-18 an experience that promotes sportsmanship, instruction, teamwork, respect for, and enjoyment of the game of baseball.

Legends 13U Tryouts:

There is no cost to tryout for the Legends Baseball Club. We require all interested players to register on-line at <https://www.legendbaseballclub.org/2018-legends-tryouts> to provide player contact information to communicate the results of tryouts for perspective players. Players will be offered positions the week of July 30th via email or phone. Due to the competitiveness of select/summer baseball, if your player is offered a position on the Legends 13U team, we will require a response within 24 hours of the offer and a \$200 deposit within 7 days to secure the players spot on the roster.

13U Team Season Focus:

Winter Training: January 1st-February 28th.

Workouts will be primarily indoors at Elite Training Academy in Monroe 2-3 times per week. Winter workouts will concentrate on hitting, pitching and fielding mechanics.

Pre-Season: March 1-Mid April:

We'll move into outdoor training and preparing for the season 3-4 times per week. Practices will consist of fundamentals, game situations, and scrimmages.

League Season: Mid April-July

Legends 13U plans to participate in the Seattle Elite Baseball, North Division. Games will most likely be played in East King/Snohomish county (Kirkland-Marysville) with our home fields (54'/80') at Lake Tye #2 or Sky River #4 in Monroe. The Seattle Elite League consists of 20-25 league games and an end of season tournament in June/July. In years past, Seattle Elite has worked with coaches to schedule games to have the ability to limit/avoid longer distance travel mid-week. We may play some double headers on the weekend to limit weekday travel.



Tournaments March-July:

We will play in 5-6 tournaments between March and July. Our tentative plan is to host one tournament, play in 2-3 more local tourneys and travel to two tournaments.

Costs:

Legends prides ourselves on offering the most competitive rates in the area. Since we are a 501(c)3 non-profit we have the ability to supplement some of our costs from generous donations and volunteer hours that are supported by corporate matching donations from participating business in the greater Seattle area (Boeing and Microsoft to name a couple). Our costs are all inclusive and include, but not limited to; league and tournament fees, uniforms, training and field rental, umpires, equipment and other essential items to run a successful baseball club. Our costs do not include travel to games or hotel stays for the out of town tournaments (approximately 2 out of town tournaments in 2019).

We are still finalizing our budget for 2019 but cost can be expected to be between \$600-\$800 for the season
