CURRENT WORDING:

2. PLAYER REGISTRATION: Each player must be registered with the NDAHA and USA Hockey, Inc. before playing in his/her first game. If a player's registration is not received by the ND Associate Registrar before his/her first game, the player will not be eligible for State, Regional, and National Tournament play. The ND Associate Registrar will send the prescribed fees to the NDAHA Treasurer and USA Hockey, Inc. Late registration of a player will be handled on a case-by-case basis with the ND Associate Registrar and District Directors.

SPECIFIC WORDING OF PROPOSAL:

2. PLAYER REGISTRATION: Each player must be registered with the NDAHA and USA Hockey, Inc. before playing in his/her first game. If a player's registration is not received by the ND Associate Registrar before his/her first game, the player will not be eligible for State, Regional, and National Tournament play. **As allowed by USA Hockey, Inc., a female player may register and play on a Youth team and or a Girls/Women's team.** ~~The ND Associate Registrar will send the prescribed fees to the NDAHA Treasurer and USA Hockey, Inc.~~ Late registration of a player will be handled on a case-by-case basis with the ND Associate Registrar and District Directors.

INTENTION OF PROPOSAL:

Housekeeping to update our rules with our practices since approximately 2017

1. Clarify a female player may play on a youth or girls/woman's team (consistent with December 17, 2025 USA Hockey Participant Eligibility Policy)
2. Associate Registrar does not collect and remit fees, these are all done electronically.
