Covid-19 Guidelines

The Hazen-Beulah North Stars welcome you to our arena. To comply with the ND Smart Restart guidelines and provide a safer environment for participants, spectators, and workers, the following guidelines will be in place at the Hazen All-Seasons Arena. In addition, each opposing home school district has established their own guidelines regarding spectator attendance which will result in varying numbers of spectators allowed. We intend to publish opponent guidelines on our social media sites but ask that you understand that all guidelines are subject to change. Please be sure to check guidelines prior to leaving for a contest to ensure compliance.

Health and Safety Protocols within Hazen All-Seasons Arena

Masks must be worn by all participants, officials and attendees at all times, except for players and officials on the ice or bench (if participating in the ice session). It is recommended that coaches wear masks on the benches and should avoid close contact with players. Coaches and players must wear masks while in the locker rooms or coaches rooms.

Everyone in attendance at an activity should remain socially distanced off the ice unless related.

Entrance & Exiting of the Arena is limited to within 15 minutes of practices and events, and 45 minutes prior to games. All participants should vacate the arena within 15 minutes of the end of the event or game. Please do not congregate in any common area within the arena.

Players (other than goalies) should come as dressed as possible in their hockey gear.

Locker rooms - Players will need to use extra effort to ensure their equipment is located near them, and not strewn about the locker room. Players shall keep their distance from other players as much as possible. Mask wearing is required in the locker room. It is recommended that players dress as much as they can prior to arriving at the rink. There will be absolutely no eating, gum chewing, or spitting in the locker rooms.

Termite and Mite players will not be assigned a locker room and should come fully dressed for practice.

Maximum of (1) parent(s) or spectator(s) per skating participant for practices and (2) parent(s) or spectator(s) and siblings during games. These numbers may change based on occupancy levels as allowed by ND Smart Restart Guidelines.

Practice social distancing. Stay at least six feet apart from anyone outside of your group.

Practice good hand washing and use hand sanitizers provided.

Do not share water bottles or hockey equipment.

Concessions - Concessions will be open. All concession workers will wear masks and use gloves as appropriate, wash hands, and sanitize preparation and eating spaces often. Spectators are to please use social distancing procedures in the concessions' room and upstairs; use hand sanitizer before and after eating; and ensure all food containers are properly disposed of. Concession workers will complete extra sanitizing measures in public spaces before, during, and after games.

No Spitting anywhere in the facility.

Avoid hand shaking, hugs or other close contact.

In the last 48 hours have you experienced any of the following symptoms?**

Before entering the Hazen All-Seasons Arena, Please consider the following:

Common Symptoms:

- Fever of 100.5 degrees Fahrenheit or above
- Dry cough
- Fatigue

Less Common Symptoms:

- Body aches and pains
- Sore Throat
- Diarrhea
- New Loss of smell or taste
- Headache

Serious symptoms:

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Chest pain or pressure

If you were able to answer YES to any of the above symptoms or been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19, Please do not enter the building and follow all local public health recommendations.
