Ice Rental Guidelines

- The SW entrance will be used for entering and exiting the building. Park in lot 60, PEIF lot. This lot can be found off the corner of East Fair and Presque Isle Avenue (behind Invent@NMU and Temaki and Tea/Smoothie King).
- Please follow the directional signs as you enter and exit the building.
- Everyone must wear a face mask as they enter and leave the building.
- Everyone must come dressed to skate.
- Locker rooms and showers will be closed.
- Each child is allowed one (1) family member to attend the skating session. The family member can help the child put on his/her skates. The family member can sit in the designated seating area to watch the skating session. The family member must wear a face mask from the point of entry into the building until departure from the building.
- Everyone must bring their own water bottle. All drinking fountains will be shut off. Any water bottles left in the building at the end of each day will be thrown away.
- Please email a list of participants in your rental group to Carl Bammert ([cbammert@nmu.edu](mailto:cbammert@nmu.edu)). Please include a phone number for each person. The list will be available as you enter the ice. If the participant's name is not on the list, they can add their name and phone number. This list would be used for contract tracing, if needed due to a positive COVID-19 diagnosis to an individual who entered the building.
- A decision will be made by mid-August if teams from outside of region 8, the Upper Peninsula, can participate in games at the Berry Events Center.

These COVID-19 related guidelines change the Berry Events Center experience, but they are necessary to protect the users and employees of the building and keep the arena open.
