Please be aware that all players, coaches, parents, guardians and spectators are entering the facility at their own risk, including but not limited to the risks associated with Covid-19

FACILITY PROTOCOLS for PLAYERS:

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

DO NOT ENTER ARENA OR LOCKER ROOM WITH ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS or related symptoms; or after exposure to someone with COVID-19.

YOUTH HOCKEY ARENA RULES: NO LOCKER ROOMS; NO BAGS

MASKS: ALL PLAYERS/COACHES MASKED AT ALL TIMES (INCLUDING ICE AND BENCHES)

ENTER AND EXIT FULLY DRESSED: (No sooner than 15 mins before and 10 mins after ice time): Helmets and skates may be put on in the rink.

-Masks should be worn while entering and exiting the arena & on the ice

For PARENTS/GUARDIANS and SPECTATORS

RI GUIDELINES FOR CAPACITY ENFORCED; 2 SPECTATORS PER PLAYER ALLOWED FOR GAMES; 1 SPECTATOR FOR PRACTICES

PARKING LOT: Congregating in the parking lot is not allowed.

MASKS: face coverings required at all times anywhere on the premises inside or out

SOCIAL DISTANCE: Social Distancing required at all times 6 feet apart

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GAME VIEWING: Viewing is allowed in the upper deck socially distanced along the railing; no standing at glass or within 14 feet of playing surface.

-Do not congregate in the lobby or around the building before or after your game

Please keep in mind that these precautions are necessary to keep the kids on the ice. Please adhere to them so we can continue to keep your child, coaches, staff, and spectators safe.
