



Fundraising Participation Guidelines-Annual Raffle

To provide an opportunity to offset costs associated with playing on a Classic City Volleyball club team, we have created a fundraising opportunity for our athletes. A raffle will be held to distribute purchased and donated prizes. Your participation will allow you to raise money directly for your personal club, travel, and equipment costs.

There are two ways you can help with this effort: 1) solicit sponsor donations of items, gift cards, services, items from businesses or people you know, and 2) sell raffle tickets to friends, family, colleagues, etc. Examples of sponsor donations might include a day at the salon, a free round of golf, restaurant discounts, a massage, or merchandise.

Anyone that participates will pay a proportional amount towards the cost of prizes. More donated prizes will reduce this cost and more sold tickets will minimize the cost per person. Each participant will buy a deck(s) of playing cards (~\$1 at Dollar General) and sell either one card for \$5 each, or a multipack of 5 cards for \$20. Write the contributor's name and phone number on the actual card. Also write the name of the player that sold the card(s). All sold cards will be collected with the money donated and the drawing be on Saturday morning, December 13. After any pro-rated cost of the prizes is covered (and any delinquent club fees owed), the player will keep all remaining raised funds to be applied however they wish to offset the cost of equipment, club fees, travel costs, etc.

There are recent examples where over \$1000 was raised by one player very quickly with little effort. It is an easy process, with proven results. By selling only 25 cards, you can pay for your equipment package. Creative applications include the following:

- Take a deck of cards to work with the Raffle Flyer and get co-workers to participate.
- Share the idea with friends at school, church, or in other groups.
- Ask family members for support during the holidays.
- Share the idea on Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat and use Venmo to collect money.
- Give a friend a deck of cards and ask them to help at their workplace or school.
- Setup a table in the neighborhood and post pictures of prizes for neighbors to stop and buy tickets.

Rules

1. Playing cards should be normal size (roughly 2-1/4" x 3-1/2"). No jumbo or mini cards. (Card backing, color, design does not matter.) Do not fold cards.
2. All money collected must be in an envelope marked with the player's name and turned in to a Club Director with the sold, labeled playing cards by 630pm Friday, December 12.
3. Cards must include the name of the purchaser, the purchaser's phone number and the name of the player who sold the card.
