

NEW CLUB APPLICATION PROCESS

To protect the growth of Ontario Volleyball’s membership and in consideration of existing clubs, the following minimum standards have been established for new member club applications.

APPLICATION INCLUDES:	FIRST YEAR OBLIGATIONS
Step 1: Application received by Ontario Volleyball through, including five-year goals and agreement form; Step 2: Provincial Advisory Council (PAC) review	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➔ Complete the one time \$500.00 application fee ➔ One-year probation to be reviewed at the end of the first season; ➔ All Ontario Volleyball policies and procedures are met.

New club applications will be taken during the month of June preceding the start of the next indoor season. Applications, reviews and interviews (if required) will be completed during this time to prepare any successful club for affiliation starting in August. Applications will not be accepted or approved during any other time during the calendar year.

For an application to be considered, all application questions must be completed in full and all corresponding documents attached. Once these submissions have been reviewed an interview maybe required. All submissions will be forwarded to the Provincial Advisory Council (PAC) for final review.

This application process is for any Club who want to participate in OVA indoor tournaments.

FEES

- New member clubs - \$500

Application Overview:

- Complete the Questionnaire/Application form
- Sign an agreement to abide by all OVA policies, including, but not limited to:

 - OVA’s insurance requirements

- Interview (if deemed necessary)
