Winter Training Sessions:

We are pleased to announce that we have secured The Forty – Athlete HQ for winter training sessions. These sessions will be Tuesdays and Thursdays starting on Tuesday, January 6th and concluding Tuesday, March 31st. This will be for 10U and Up age groups and there will be a separate email going on regarding more specific timeframes and session information, so be on the lookout for that!

Registration Updates:

Through December 14th, 2025 we have had 52 kids sign up for baseball, which is about 40% of what was signed up last year at the same time. The original deadline to sign up was December 31st, 2025, for 10U through Legion and February 28th, 2026 for TeeBall through 8U without a late fee, and a hard cutoff date of 03/31/2026. We are extending the 10U through Legion Deadline to January 31st, 2026, without a late fee. For those not registered yet (10U and above), we invite you to come visit one of the winter workout sessions to see what we are putting together as a program. Make sure to check out the Winter Workout Session email that comes out for details.

Also, don't forget that we implemented 2 payment options this year. You can either pay in full at time of registration or have your payment broken up into 6 monthly payments.

District 4 Amateur Baseball Tournament:

The Hartford/Humboldt Gamecocks received approval to host the District 4 Amateur Baseball Tournament in 2026. This will be held July 24th through August 1st with over 16 games played over the course of the week. These games will be held at Bob Needels Field (Field A) in Humboldt.

WCBA has been given the opportunity to run concessions and 50/50 raffle to help make money for the association. The Gamecocks will raise money for their program through the alcohol sales, meals, and gate fees.

WCBA will work with the Gamecocks to give our full support where we can to help create a successful tournament.
