## Respect Roughs Up Good N' Plenty

Both teams came into this one with 2-4 records looking to climb out of mediocrity. Respect jumped out early in the 1st inning by smacking hit after hit down the leftfield line. Jackie Farca's drove in Solly "loose" for the 1st run. The top of the lineup was incredible for Respect, the first 6 men of the lineup combined for 10 runs in the 1st 2 innings. Jeffrey Saka scored twice including a grand slam down the line to give his team a 10-2 lead. Respect had their best hitting performance of the year. They scored in each of the 7 innings except the 5th. Five Respect batters had 3 hits in this game alone. Jackie Farca, Elliot Braha, and Jeffrey Saka all drove in at least 3 runs. The game was almost as bad of a massacre as the Happy Daze game (see Wizz Kidzz-Happy Daze). On a bright note for Good N' Plenty, Eric Epstein gave some life to his team with a blast in the rightfield gap for a 2 run homer. But it wasn't pretty, Good 'n Plenty were never in the game, and Respect had every batter in the lineup scoring at some point in the game. Although Saka only had one hit, it was a dagger in the heart in the form of a grand slam. His 5 RBI's led the team to an 18 run game.

## Late Respect Comeback Gives Them the Sweep

Jack Gemal led off the game with a home run. It didn't stop there, Michael Beyda, Eric Epstein, Sandy Shalom all singled. Abie Kassin came up with the big hit to drive in a few runs. Before you knew it, Good N' Plenty had built a solid 4-nothing lead. But they gave back one run in the bottom of the 1st after Maurice Haber drove in Solly Chehebar. Charlie Ashko, who has been hitting very well of late, tripled deep into leftfield. Sammy Sitt knocked him in. Abie Kassin's 4th inning double gave Good N' Plenty the comfortable lead. In the 4th inning though, Respect staged a comeback to bring them back within a run. Down 6-2, David Braka drilled a shot deep into centerfield for a triple. Labo and Braka both scored. To make it 6-4. After Jackie Farca walked, Jackie Braha and Maurice Haber singled to ignite a 3-run rally. They took the 7-6 lead on a couple of crucial GNP errors in the infield. GNP had their chance to try and get the tying run, but Solly Chehebar put the nail in the coffin with his huge at bat in the 6th. He slapped a line drive to opposite field which got by Kassin for a 2-run homer. This gave Respect the 9-6 win, the sweep, and a 4-2 record. As for GNP, they've struggled over the last couple of weeks. Although they've showed signs of life, and that they can play tough defence and hit well, they have not done those things consistently.

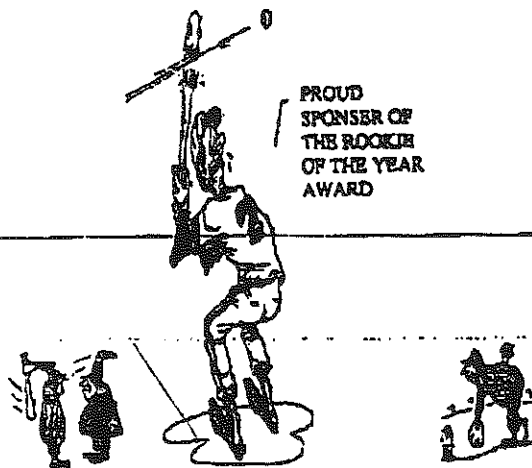


