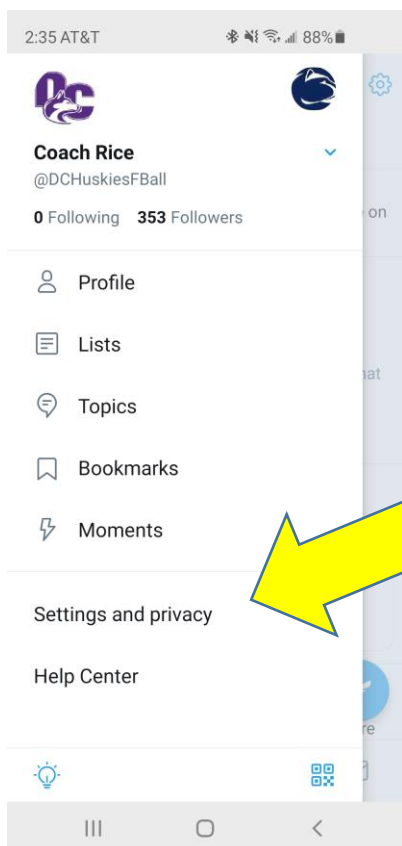


Directions for getting Tweet Notifications

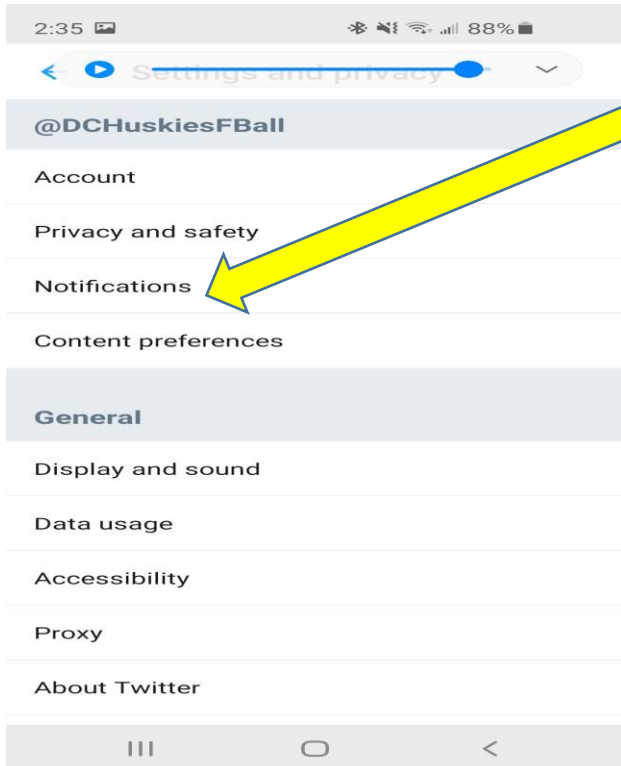
Twitter has recently ceased to allow notifications to come through as text messages. If you would still like to receive notifications when @DCHuskiesFBall tweets, please follow these instructions:

Turn-on notifications by going to your account, settings and privacy, and turning on notifications. See step-by-step below (from the mobile app):

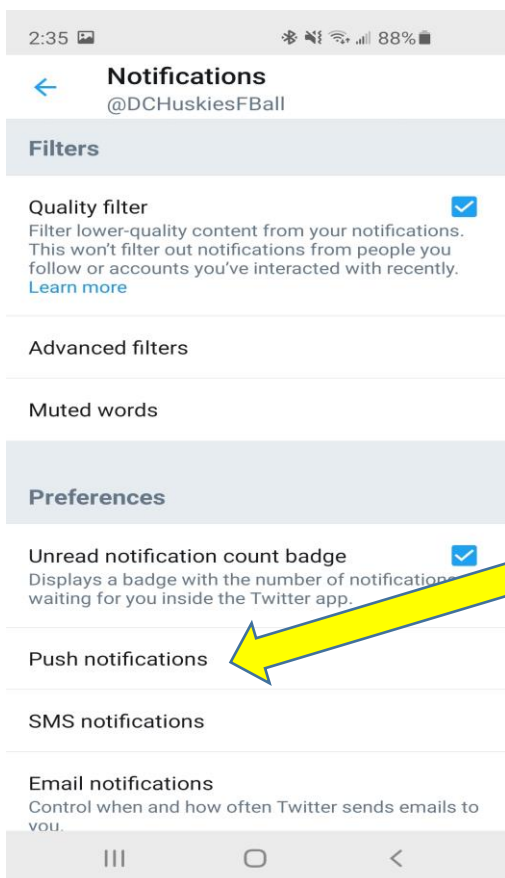
- 1. Go to your profile and click on “settings and privacy”:**



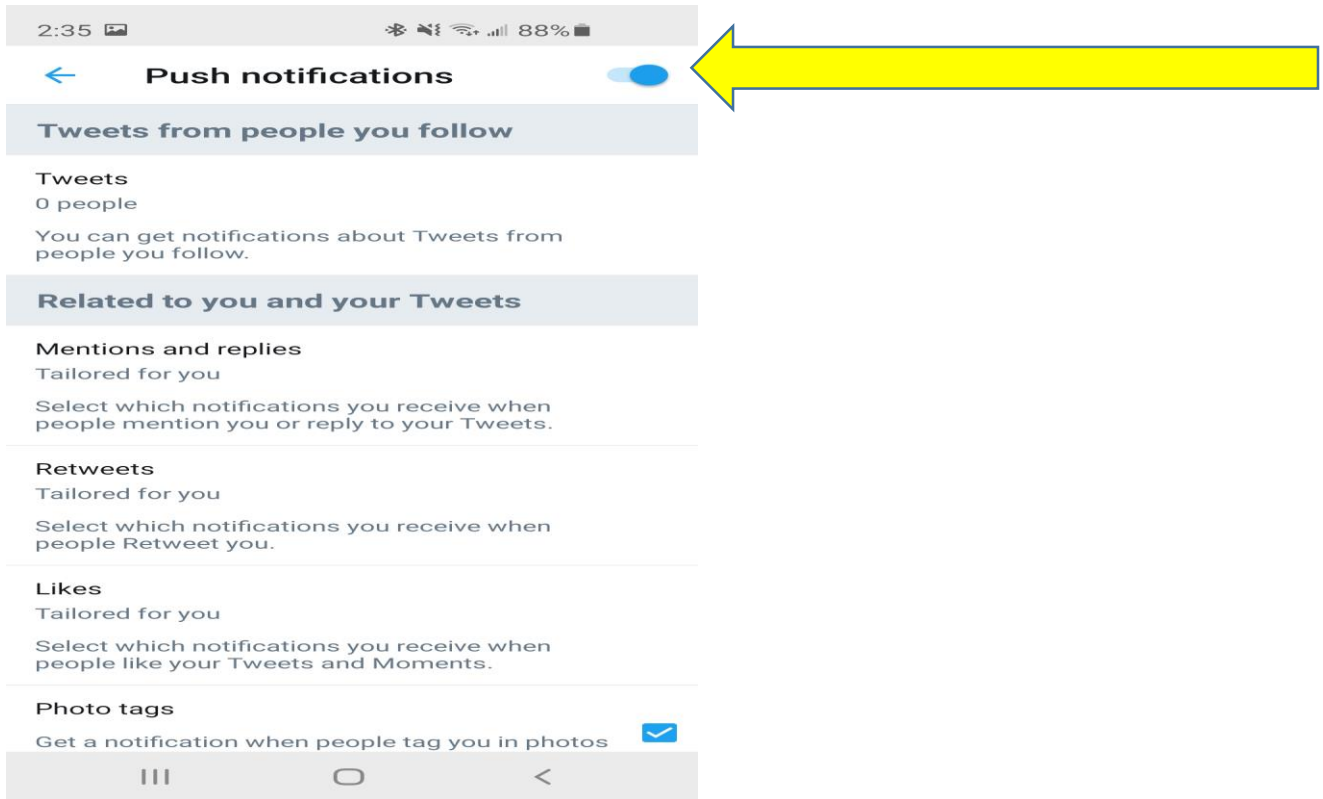
2. Then, click on “Notifications”:



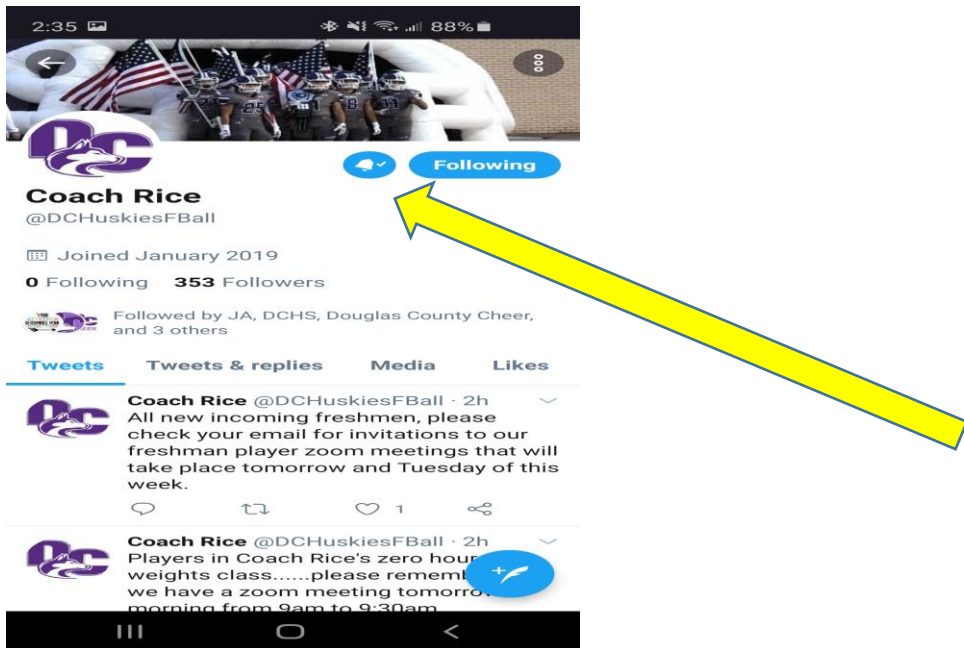
3. Then, click on “Push Notifications”:



4. **Once you are in “Push Notifications,” you need to make sure they are turned-ON:**



5. **Finally, you need to make sure you are getting tweet notifications from @DCHuskiesFBall. Go to this account and select the “bell” to enable the notifications:**



You can also enable notifications from your computer, by following the same steps (although, it may look a little different).
