Evaluators: 6 outside evaluators have been secured

They will look at:

Dribbling: Ability to control ball, dribbles with both hands, maintains control, head up and ball control.

Passing: Demonstrates proper passing technique

Shooting: Squares up toward the basket and takes aim before releasing the ball.

Lay-ups: Proper technique with Dribbles, steps and shoots in one continuation motion

Rebounding: Boxes out/times jump and extends arms to retrieve ball off rim/put backs/aggressiveness

Defense: Contains ball handler and slides properly/help defense/close out/anticipation/deny defense/blocking out

Aggressiveness: Play maker whether offensively or defensively/on the floor loose balls

Team Player: Knows there are FOUR other players on the court also/Positive towards team/hustles

Court Knowledge: Sees the whole court and knows where to be during play/Moving without the ball/setting and

Coaches Interviews: Jen, Mike and Kerry will interview 9/9

Hamre would like these questions asked: Will you run the read and react offense? Jen has other questions prepared.
