



## RTJBL Travel Team Code of Conduct - 2020

***Players and Parents need to accept and sign below.***

- Be organized with your equipment for practice and games.
- Be on time for practices or games; alert the coach or manager when running late.
- Always practice and play together as a team.
- Work to improve baseball skills outside of team practices and games.
- Always hustle and do the best you can.
- Pick up teammates, don't bring them down! Never criticize a teammate for making a mistake or striking out.
- Be committed to the team, you may start practices in February and play through July. Unless otherwise stated by the manager, families should avoid vacations during the late spring and summer until the season is over. Missing players puts the team at a disadvantage, and is not fair to other families who are attending games and practices.
- An unexcused absence from a practice, scrimmage, or game will result in sitting on the bench for the first two innings of the next scheduled scrimmage or game. This is cumulative and is the minimum the manager must do to enforce this rule.\*
- Participate in at least 65% of our Recreation League games (as stated in League Bylaws).
- Trust in the coach's in the dugout to be the only ones coaching during a game or practice.
- Respect the coach's decisions to put us in a position on the field that they see will be in the best interest of the team at that time.
- No displays of frustration by slamming equipment.
- No use of profanity.
- No other adults except coaches allowed in the dugout unless there is a medical necessity or any other health related issue.
- Allow 24 hours before voicing a concern to the coaches.
- Show good sportsmanship to the umpires, opposing players, coaches, families, and the opposing fans. You are representing Readington and Tewksbury Townships with your behavior during and after the game.
- Have fun and enjoy the game!
