- Policy re: minimum time between games
 - Does it vary by age group?
 - I.e., does U19 need more time between games than U15/U12?

- Scheduling
 - U-12 divisions
 - last year more U12 teams declared than any other age level = resulted in 2 divisions created: front range and mountains
 - Goal: 16-20 games of league play
 - **No more U-12 divisions**
 - Try to have U-15 and U-19 travel together
 - Try to do 4 weekends of 4 game jamborees? (1 home 3 away)
 - Challenging locations for hosting a U-12 jamboree weekend: Air Force, Durango

 - U-10 Jamborees?
 - Tier II and MSGHL scheduling
 - schedule earlier?
 - Season starts Oct. 15th
 - Tier II needs to work with MSGHL - Andrea needs to work on this
 - Make Thanksgiving weekend a AA blackout weekend

 - Periodic schedule audits
 - Ensure that nothing changes
 - Responsibility for such—MSGHL scheduler, home scheduler, away scheduler?

- Rule changes
 - Last year's lost rules
 - 48 hour rule remains for game cancellations
 - Additional changes?

- Skipping MSGHL Tournament

- Penalty
 - Should there be a commitment deadline?
 - **Teams MUST withdraw or “opt out” of state tournament by JANUARY 31st.**
 - If a team withdraws from state tournament after this date, they are responsible for covering the tournament fee for the next team moved into their playoff spot
- Enforcement
- Front Range growth
 - How does it look through the schedule?
 - CRHL is voting on getting rid of checking in bantams and midgets - will this impact girls numbers?
- Tier II teams and players
 - Presence of Tier II teams in the league
 - Tier II dominating league play
 - AA has their own state tournament
 - Goal is to help with game count
 - **Tier II will NOT participate in state tournament or league play**
 - Tier II teams competing in MSGHL must play up an age division
 - Games against Tier II will be friendly scrimmages and not count towards standings
 - Limit to number of Tier II players on an MSGHL team?
 - **There WILL NOT be a limit of Tier II girls allowed to play on a MSGHL team**
 - **MSGHL is rec league and must include all local players without tryouts or cuts**

- Colorado Girls Hockey League
 - **New League composed of only Colorado teams**
