## **February:**

1st – Mandatory Head Coach and Rules Interpretation meetings – Roncalli High School (3300 N Prague Road, Indianapolis, IN 46227)

**\*Penalty for missing is ineligibility for State Tournament and could result in Coach Suspension of game(s)**

1st– 2020 Rules agreement is due–**\*team forfeits all games until agreement is submitted\***

10<sup>th</sup> – **All coaches must be registered with US Lacrosse AND on INGLA website.**

- This is for all Head Coaches, Assistants, JV Coaches, and managers, etc. No Exceptions.

10<sup>th</sup>- **All first-year head coaches must have completed the US Lacrosse Level 1 online certification course by this date.**

10<sup>th</sup> – Games canceled after this date become forfeits to canceling team.

10<sup>th</sup> – **Team practices may begin if dues have been paid, all coaches are registered with US lacrosse and on the league website, signed rules agreement has been submitted, and games on the arbiter have been verified.**

**Penalty: Coach is suspended and all games are forfeited.**

28<sup>th</sup> – **All players MUST BE members of US Lacrosse AND registered on the INGLA website. Penalty: After this date, if a player is not a member of US Lacrosse and registered on the INGLA website, she is not allowed to practice and play in any scrimmages/games. If a player is found to be non-compliant and practicing/playing, the head coach will be subject to penalties which may include the team's exclusion from league and US Lacrosse awards and the State Tournament.**

**28<sup>th</sup> - All players must be concussion/Impact tested** – verification of such should be sent to league secretary. Remember all players must be tested prior to stepping out with the team for any activity.

**28<sup>th</sup>- 1<sup>st</sup>** – All second year or later head coaches must be level 1 certified. **\*Penalty is ineligibility for State Tournament.**

**March:**

**6<sup>th</sup>** - Opening Day for games (All players and coaches must be members of US Lacrosse and registered on the INGLA website. Players must also meet the concussion compliance) **Penalty: After this date, if a player is not a member of US Lacrosse and not registered on the INGLA website, she is not allowed to practice and play in any scrimmages/games. If a player is found to be non-compliant and practicing/playing, the head coach will be subject to penalties which may include the team's exclusion from league, US Lacrosse awards, and the State Tournament.**

**April:**

**TBD** – US Lacrosse All American Nominations due (Info to follow from Awards Committee)

**May:**

**2<sup>nd</sup>** - Last day to withdraw from INGLA Playoffs (You must notify the INGLA Board)

**9<sup>th</sup>**- **Last day of INGLA Regular Season**

**11<sup>th</sup>**- Rain date/make-up date for regular season games. (Sectional games take priority for ranking purposes)

**14<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>** – **SECTIONALS/REGIONALS** may begin on the 14<sup>th</sup> and must be finalized on the 21<sup>st</sup>. Winner of each sectional moves to Final Four.

**29<sup>th</sup>**- **State Tournament Semi-Finals** (Class 1A and 2A) – May 28<sup>th</sup> may be used as an alternative date if scheduling conflicts arise for the Semi-Finals.

**30<sup>th</sup>** – **State Tournament Finals**
