Eastvale Little League 2020 Practice Program

1. Follow all local and state guidelines for facilities and events.
2. Eastvale Little League (ELL) expects:
 - 1) Practice social distancing;
 - 2) Any person who is experiencing symptoms of sickness will be prohibited from attending the event/venue of play; and
 - 3) Make clear that all posted and published local and state regulated guidelines shall be followed.
3. ELL will engage in proactive steps in creating social distancing environments.
 - a. Inspect designated seating and viewing areas for parents.
 - b. When using an EZ Up, it will be restricted to family members only.
 - c. Minimize the use of fields at facilities to remain within the current mass gathering limitations of the local jurisdiction.
4. Minimize player contact by ensuring players are separated into small groups of six players or less. If groups are warming up or participating in practice drills they will stay on opposite sides of the field to ensure proper distancing. Players will observe contactless interactions when at the park.
5. Players organized in groups will only participate in activities exclusive to their group.
6. Directors, players, umpires and spectators must adhere to the guidelines from CDC.
7. Players should bring their own, personal cooler instead of using a team cooler. Players should plan on bringing an individual water bottle.

Campers

1. No handshakes.
2. No sharing of Helmets
3. No sharing of equipment.
4. No sharing of drinks
5. Maintain 6 feet of space when possible.
6. No seeds.
7. Players may wear PPE if they choose.
8. Players and coaches will follow PPE mask guidelines when travelling to and from the park.

ELL Coaches

1. No handshakes.
2. Practice social distancing guidelines when possible.
3. All involved in the camping event get a pre-screen.
4. If someone has symptomatology, they need to go home and the safety officer needs to be notified.
5. Coaches need to disinfect equipment prior to player use.
6. No group snacks.
7. No group water.
8. No sharing of gear.
9. No seeds.

Parents

1. All parents of Players will sign a liability waiver.
2. Maintain social distancing, parents are expected to stay 6' apart.
3. Those of advanced age or compromised health are recommended to not attend.
4. Parents must follow county and state mask guidelines and use hand sanitizer.
5. Parents need to disinfect personal equipment, prior to and after the camp.
6. Parents are expected to leave after the camp, no congregating.

League Items

1. Hand sanitizer available in the snack bar.
2. Hand sanitizer will be provided to each team.
3. Ensure back-up equipment (extra catchers helmets) are ready for use in case of damaged gear or if a team forgets their equipment bag.
4. Post signs around fields encouraging social distancing and explaining safety rules.
5. Kids or parents with symptomatology need a doctor's note to return to play.
6. Signs will be posted explaining social distancing rules.
7. Thermometer maintained at the field for use.
