In addition to registering their athletes through Hytek Team Manager, coaches will need to send a list of athlete names, birthdate (year, month, date), gender, and their events to maria_gorelova@sd33.bc.ca for verification purposes.

*** If you are unable to complete your entries via Team Manager, teams can pay \$50 to have the entries completed for them (this cost will be added to your meet fees)**

Teacher Sponsor: Each team must always be accompanied by a teacher sponsor, or the swimmers will not be able to compete (this requirement may be fulfilled by the principal of a school sending a letter with another team, designating a teacher from within the same school district as sponsor/chaperone). *Teacher sponsor names and contact information must be submitted with the team roster and this person must attend the meet. Any changes to the Teacher Sponsor must be communicated to the Meet Manager immediately. **Should a Teacher Sponsor not attend the Meet or proof of designate change not be provided in writing by the school Principal, the swimmers/team may be disqualified from competition.**

Team Registration: It is the responsibility of coaches to ensure that their school is registered with BC School Sports and that each athlete is eligible for competition.

Team Roster: Teams must submit a copy of their team roster to maria_gorelova@sd33.bc.ca (no later than October 17, 2025)

Please note that students in Grade 7 are NOT eligible to participate in BC School aquatics.

Scratches: Early (courtesy) scratch deadline 1700 hrs (5:00pm), Oct 25, 2025.

Coaches “should” inform admin of scratch on the day of the meet as soon as possible.

Deck Entries: deck entries and changes are not permitted without approval of the Meet Manager and Meet Referee. **Due to time constraints at the meet, changes after the start of the meet are not permitted for any reason.**

Meet Rules:

- Swimmers will be classified as outlined in the BC School Sports Handbook and Directory – Aquatics (see linked PDF [2024/25 BCSS Handbook](#)).
- Swim meet rules governing the meet will be SNC and SWIM BC rules.
- **Swimmers must be entered with entry times, or the entries will not be accepted** (electronics coordinator will not contact coaches who enter swimmers with no times). Coaches can ask BC Summer Swim, Swim BC athletes for their previous times or use estimates based on practice times.
- All swimmers must meet BC School sports eligibility rules.
- Swimmer's age must be included on the entry grids.
- Swimmers must be entered in events representing the secondary school at which they are registered; all teams must submit their team roster prior to competition to BCSS.
- **Swimmers may compete in up to and including 4 events (being listed as a relay alternate and the Mixed relay - exhibition swim is considered as an event)**
- B Swimmers may swim in B or Open category relays but may not swim in the same relay in both the Open and B event (ex. Open 200 Relay or B 200 Relay but not both).
- B Swimmers are permitted to swim in both Open and B individual events of the same race.
- **Once the meet is seeded, scratches will be taken, but the meet will not**

be reseeded.

- The no false start rule will be in effect.
 - **Coaches are responsible for getting swimmers to the blocks; swimmers who miss their event will not be allowed to re-swim the event (this is a cardless meet).** Soft marshalling support will be in the lobby for athletes requiring assistance.
 - **Relay swimmers must swim in the order entered or they will be disqualified.**
 - A maximum of two relay teams per event per school may advance to the BC High School Aquatic Championships.
 - A mixed relay must consist of two females and two males. Mixed relays are swum as EXT and do not qualify for points.
- * **All races are swum as timed finals.**

Eligibility and Classification:

Open (A) Category Swimmer

- A student- athlete with a SNC (Swimming Natation Canada) number who has competed at a winter swim meet since September 1st, 2024 are considered Open category.
- A student-athlete who trains at a Swim Academy

B Category Swimmer

- As of January 1st of the championship year (2025), the swimmer trains and competes from May 1 to September 1 with no restrictions.
- Any student-athlete that does not fit the 'A' swimmer definition (Coaches are reminded that if a 'B' swimmer competes in any meet between September 1 and the date of the Regional Championship they are no longer a B swimmer)

Para Swimmers

- All para swimmers must be classified by a BCSS designated classifier to compete at the Championship.
- Classification for Para Swimming Competitors:
 - S1-10 is for physical impairment
 - S11-13 is for visual impairment
 - S14 is for intellectual impairment

Entry Instructions:

1. Entries will be completed using Team Manager (Team Manager can be downloaded at the link [Hytek Downloads](#))
2. The Team Manager file will be sent out by October 10, 2024
3. Completed entries, athletic roster and full list of athlete names, birthdate (year, month, date), gender, and their events should be submitted to maria_gorelova@sd33.bc.ca prior to Friday October 17, 2025 - 9:00pm.
4. A psych sheet and fee report will be sent via email by October 22, 2025 - 9:00pm
5. Relay name change deadline: October 25, 2025 - 1:00pm.
6. Corrections need to be sent via email to maria_gorelova@sd33.bc.ca prior to Thursday, October 23, 2025

- Individual points 10 8 6 5 4 3 2 1 (top 10)
- Relay points 20 16 12 10 8 6 4 2 (top 10)
- * Mixed relays are EXT and do not qualify for points

Team Banners:

- Junior Male Aggregate (grades 8-10 and under 17 years)
- Junior Female Aggregate (grades 8-10 and under 17 years)
- Senior Male Aggregate (grades 11-12 and under 19 years)
- Senior Female Aggregate (grades 11-12 and under 19 years)

Only two years of eligibility at senior level

BC Championships:

The top 3 (three) entries in each event (individual and relay) will qualify for the High School Provincial Championship meet to be held on November 14 and 15, 2025 at Watermania in Richmond.

Results from the zone meet will be sent directly to the Entries Manager of the Provincial Championships.

Swimmers should inform their coaches by the conclusion of the Eastern Fraser Valley Swimming Championship if they are unable to compete at the Provincial Championship Meet.

Provincial scratches must be made by November 14 , 2025

Facility Use:

Building entry: no entry permitted except to volunteers prior to 8:15am

Swimmers: 8:15am

Spectators: 8:30am

Closed Areas: all closed areas will be clearly marked and blocked off; no access to the wave pool, hot tubs, sauna, steam room or gym areas.

Changerooms: are for swimmers and coaches only

Washrooms:

Spectators: lobby restrooms and restrooms near 2nd floor viewing area entry. *For the safety and ease of use of swimmers spectators are NOT to use the changerooms.*

Swimmers: changerooms

Spectators: Entrance to the viewing deck is via the stairs/elevator in the main lobby.

No spectators on the pool deck

Swimmers:

Athletes will be seated in the viewing deck area. Lawn chairs are permitted.

Walkways and access to exits MUST be clear

Marshaling: soft marshaling support will be in the lobby for swimmers requiring assistance. There are no marshaling calls in the viewing area. Swimmers are responsible to ensure they do not miss their events. **Swimmers that have missed an event will not be allowed to re-swim.**

**It is the responsibility of the swimmers to keep the area tidy;
Coaches MUST please ensure your swimmers clean up after themselves.**

Volunteers:

Volunteers are essential to effectively host a swim meet; volunteers are required for a variety of positions during the meet:

- Timers and recorders
- Stroke and Turn officials
- Deck Officials (Ref, Back-up Ref, Clerk of Course, Chief Timer, Starter)
- Food Service (leadership students often volunteer for this position)
- Security
- Safety Marshalls
- Set-up
- Take down

Schools who choose not to provide the requisite numbers of volunteers may, at the discretion of the Meet Manager, be prohibited from competing.

Event set up:

Saturday, Oct. 25: 4:00pm - 6:00pm.

Sunday, Oct 26: 7:30am - 8:30am

Take down:

Volunteers needed for view deck clean up - takes about 30 minutes after meet end.
