## BASEBALL OPERATIONS INTERNSHIP

### Overview:

The Baseball Operations Intern will actively support Bismarck Youth Baseball's programs during the 2026 season. This internship provides hands-on experience in tournament and game operations, site supervision, equipment management, ticketing, and other key aspects of youth baseball. Interns will work closely with the Executive Director and gain valuable skills in sports management and event operations.

**Start/Completion Date:** May 18, 2026 (flexible) – August 2, 2026

### Duties and Responsibilities:

Intern responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Assisting with league and travel baseball operations.
- Supervising game-day activities, including site management, ticketing, and field checks.
- Organizing and managing equipment and uniforms.
- Supporting pre-tournament preparation and on-site tournament operations.
- Performing tasks and projects assigned by BYB Staff.
- Assisting with managing employees and volunteers as directed.
- Completing other duties as assigned to support the organization's operations.

### Qualifications:

- Currently pursuing a degree in Sports Management, Business, Education, or a related field.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite and Google Workspace.
- Strong organizational and time-management skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal abilities.
- Enthusiastic and committed to working in youth sports.
- Knowledge of baseball is preferred.

### Additional Information:

- Internship duration: Mid-May through early August.
- Interns will work 30-40 hours per week, including evenings and weekends as needed.
- This is a paid internship (DOE).
- Housing will be the responsibility of the intern.
