Commissioner's Report:

- Unable to attend
- Final Postseason tournament planned – Eastern Semifinal
- Commissioner is working on next year's sites already – has one on the line for the Eastern at this point

President's Report:

- Intention of not running for President role at next AGM
- Will help transition in new administration

1st Vice-President's Report:

- There is a new interest in a team in Harrisburg – need equipment and want to host a larger scale clinic
- Gaylord team is looking at re-structuring
- Seattle has a request for consideration of grant – have an import of lower caliber – Will discuss offline – don't want to upset teams that didn't apply because they have imports
- Would like to create a training video for volunteers to learn how to work tables better – less errors during games

2nd Vice-President's Report:

- Neilsen Grant - End of February will be deadline for when teams need to submit final plan for spending money will occur is due
 - Money must be spent well before end of 2020

- Teams need to be tracking all expenses
- We should continue to consider having high profile social media folks funnel interest into USQRA social media in lead up to Nationals
